#### **DINNING OUT**

ost of us have a "go to" pizza or sub place but it is nice to change it up now and then. I recently have been introduced to two places I would like to share with you; one this month and I will save the second for next month.

GULF SIDE PIZZA & SUBS 11703 Hamlin Blvd, Largo; Sunday 12 – 10 pm Monday – Thursday 11 am – 10 pm, Friday & Saturday 10 am – 11:30 pm

This small but cozy place is less than a block off Walsingham at the last light before going over the bridge to Indian Rocks Beach. This is a good place to grab a bite to eat going to or returning from the beach. There is indoor & outdoor seating. They have a loyal following so you can be sure the food is good. On a recent visit with my brother, I had the "Hurricane Ron Sub" (\$10.95) – sauce, Italian sausage, pepperoni, ham, Provolone cheese, mushroom, onion, green pepper, banana pepper, green & black olives. My brother had the "Italian Sub" (\$10.95) - Italian dressing, ham, salami, pepperoni, onion, banana pepper, Provolone cheese, lettuce & tomato. On a tip from my brother, I asked to have the sauce in the middle of the sub rather than on the roll as it has a tendency to make the bread too soggy. Both were delicious and packed full of ingredients – no skimping there. But the best part was the Italian sub roll. It was less bready than a regular sub roll...more like a French baguette but a little wider. Later I had a small individual mushroom and pepperoni pizza. The crust was very good but a bit unusual. When I asked about it I was told they make "Ohio Style" pizza. I didn't know there was such a thing. The crust was not too thick or too thin; the sauce had just the right amount of seasoning and the toppings were plentiful. On the larger size pizzas, they cut them into squares so if you prefer the regular pie slice be sure to ask. They also have spaghetti and lasagna and sides. Definitely worth stopping by!

FYI – I got a tip from a TWVE resident that Pinellas Pizzeria at 3200 East Bay Drive is also a great place for pizza, subs, salads & entrees.





### ONE CRUST CHICKEN POT PIE WITH CAMPBELL'S CREAM OF BACON SOUP

1 can cream of bacon soup

9" PIE CRUST (I use Aldi's frozen pie crusts)

1-1/2 c. chicken pieces 3 carrots 1 small onion, diced

2 stalks celery, sliced 1c. frozen peas 3 Tbsp flour

Cook carrots, onion, celery, and peas in 1-1/2 cup water till soft (I cook the carrots whole and slice them once they are soft - I don't like having to slice hard carrots). Drain. Beat flour with milk and mix in cream of bacon soup. Add to vegetables and heat till just boiling. Layer chicken pieces in 9" pie plate. Pour vegetable mixture over chicken. Top with one pie crust.

Brush crust with 1 egg mixed in 1 Tbsp. water. Bake 40 minutes in 350 oven. Yummmmm

#### **CORN CHOWDER**

1/4 lb. bacon, cut into small pieces 1 small onion, sliced

2 c. raw potato, diced 1 c. hot water 2 Tbsp. flour

2-1/2 c. corn, cooked till tender 2 c. scalded milk

1 can Campbell's Cream of Bacon soup 2 egg yolks, lightly beaten

1 Tbsp. butter

1/2 c. milk

In large saucepan, brown bacon lightly. Add onion and cook for 2 - 3 min. Stir in potato and hot water and cook until potatoes are tender enough to mash. Thicken the mixture with flour mixed with 1/3 c. water, cold water or milk. Mix in corn, milk and Cream of Bacon soup. Bring chowder to a boil and remove from heat. Just before serving, mix a little of chowder liquid with egg yolk and butter; stir into the chowder. Sprinkle chowder with paprika and serve very hot. Enjoy!
