

From the Board of Directors

The next Board of Directors meeting will be held on Tuesday March 19th at 7pm in the clubhouse. Please mark your calendar and plan to attend. The Board also holds operations meetings at the clubhouse each Monday at 8:30 AM. These are your best bets to find out what is going on in Blue Jay.

On February 20th, Blue Jay's Annual Meeting was held in the Clubhouse in accordance with our Governing Documents. This was a Members Meeting, held for the purpose of hearing annual reports from the President, Treasurer, and all of the Committees that represent you on a daily basis. February is also "election month," when Board members are elected to represent you. This year only two candidates stepped forward to fill the two Board vacancies, and both were incumbents seeking another term. As homeowners are preparing to go north, please make sure to leave your home "hurricane ready". That means EVERYTHING is taken out of your carport and stowed indoors as well as anything else that is around your home. It is important if you have storm shutters that they be lowered before you leave. If you have someone taking care of your home in your absence you should make sure to "exercise" your shutters to assure they can be lowered in your absence. Any item can become a projectile in strong winds causing damage to your home or others. Please plan ahead for the safety of yourself and your neighbors.

Also, as you prepare to go north, please notify the Association by completing a change of address and letting us know who is looking after your home while you are gone. This ensures Association mail is received in a timely manner, and provides a local contact that can take care of issues that may occur with your home during your absence.

Please also note that Board Members will be attending mandatory Board Certification Training on Friday, March 8th. The Board will be absent from Blue Jay from about 7:30 AM until 1:00 PM.
