You will be able to see and print your account ledger, agendas, meeting minutes, homeowner financials, print commonly used forms, governing documents and rules & regulations. <u>Rules Reminders</u> – With most of the residents here, please take the time to look at your home. Some of the common violations are weeds in planter beds, bushes that need trimming, dirty awnings, items that do not belong under the carport, dirty screens or home may need pressure washing. In addition, please do not forget the following:

- 1. All motor vehicles belonging to the residents of the Community must clearly display a registration sticker on the rear window or bumper (left/driver's side). All Golf Carts belonging to residents must display a registration sticker on the rear of the vehicle (left/driver's side). If you do not have a vehicle sticker for your vehicle or golf cart, please come to the office and bring your vehicle registration so we can provide you with a new sticker.
- 2. Please be mindful of your speed. We have a lot of people who walk and ride bikes in the community and we have received some complaints about residents driving too fast. The speed limit is 15 mph.
- 3. Pets are not allowed in the common area and when walking them, please make sure you pick-up after your pet.
- 4. Please remember that no work on the outside of the home should be done without prior approval from the alteration committee and two Board members.

<u>New Residents</u> - If you recently purchased a home in Clearwater Cascade, please remember to provide the office with a copy of your Certificate of Title once you receive it.

Our Veterans' Group would like to feature one of our veteran's each month and this month we are featuring Jerry McGovern. Most of you know Jerry as one of our illustrious members of Park Patrol. Jerry was born in the Bronx in New York City, the fifth of six children. His father was a New York City policeman. October 19, 1961 Jerry joined the Army Ordinance Corps, prompted by John F. Kennedy's "Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country." He worked in the wheel and track division (tanks and truck repair). In 1963 he was sent TDY (temporary authorized duty) to Vietnam assigned to observers...but they didn't do much observing...they were in the thick of combat, involved in skirmishes for about six weeks. Then he was off to Bavaria Zirndorf Germany, just outside Nuremberg for 30 months. He received an honorable discharge in October, 1964. He continued his service to our county for three years in the Army Reserves as an SP4. Jerry said the best part of his military experience was he came away with skills and discipline which helped when he went back into civilian life. He also learned a great deal about handling people, instilling respect and confidence. "You'd be surprised what learning how to make four stiff corners on a bed teaches you." His worst time was in Vietnam, the horrors still haunt him to this day, but it was a tremendous growth experience. Jerry would like to see the Draft reinstated to help instill discipline, respect and confidence in our young men and women of today. You truly learn







about the value of being a team of brothers no matter where you served: the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, Space Corps, National Guard. Jerry is still involved with his military brothers and sisters at the American Legion Maderia Beach and just about any Veterans event. He also belongs to the Masonic Lodge and is grateful anytime he can help others through life's hardships. Jerry also treasures the eight years he served in the Pinellas Council Honor Guard at Bay Pines. Jerry, we salute you and thank you for your service to the United States of America.

CLEARWATER CASCADE HISTORY

In preparation of this article, I was looking at a copy of the 1996 CWC directory. My interest peaked at the name "Father Bob" Rolander listed as Chaplain under the office staff. I recalled seeing a memorial stone bearing his name in the memory garden which had invoked a memory of mine which was

very dear to me.

My late husband, Frank and I were renting a home on St Ann Street in 2012. Frank was quite ill and I was struggling with the decision about how I would get him back to Rochester. I decided to attend the church service at the clubhouse for support and prayers. Father Bob laid his hand on my head to give me a blessing which brought me to tears. I have always treasured that memory and shared my story with Donna Thorn. She provided me with an article she wrote in 2017 which I want to share with you.

Robert Rolander, more commonly known as Father Bob, was a resident of CWC for 40 years. When he and Cathy moved here April 1, 1975, they lived on Canal Street. He used to walk the perimeter of the park every day.

Interestingly, his first career was in "show biz". Bob played guitar and keyboard, his partner played clarinet and they traveled about playing nightclubs, lodges etc. He even played at the Pinellas Park Elks Club! He loved meeting people and enjoyed his career, but after 30 years, he was getting older and somewhat disenchanted with the direction of music. Even the excitement of Vegas didn't bring the enjoyment he had once felt. His life changed direction and he became a Priest in the Anglican faith.

Every Sunday, for the next 22 years, our clubhouse became St. Lukes' chapel with Father Bob giving a sermon. He started in June of 1990 and his last service was March 11, 2012.


An insight into the man he was is evident in the story of quarters. You see, he still felt the need to entertain. He would visit nursing homes and other venues, some where people were less fortunate. At one such place, he would bring a pocket full of quarters to give to the young people for the coke machine. After a time, the young people would line up at the gate waiting for Father Bob to arrive.

He was married to Cathryn for 42 years. She shared his calling, often going with him on those midnight calls for comfort. She joined him on visits to nursing homes too, often with bracelets she made to hand out to the ladies.

Father Bob was one of our outstanding residents and well deserves to be remembered!

Ides of March

The Ides of March (/aɪdz/; Latin: Idus Martiae, Late Latin: Idus Martii)[1] is the 74th day in the Roman calendar, corresponding to 15 March. It was marked by several religious observances and was a deadline for settling debts in Rome.[2] In 44 BC, it became notorious as the date of the assassination of Julius Caesar, which made the Ides of March a turning point in Roman history.

According to Plutarch, [19] a seer had warned that harm would come to Caesar on the Ides of March. On his way to the Theatre of Pompey, where he would be assassinated, Caesar passed the seer and joked, "Well, the Ides of March are come", implying that the prophecy had not been fulfilled, to which the seer replied "Aye, they are come, but they are not gone."[19] This meeting is famously dramatised in William Shakespeare's play *Julius Caesar*, when Caesar is warned by the soothsayer to "beware the Ides of March."[20][21] The Roman biographer Suetonius[22] identifies the "seer" as a haruspex named Spurinna. Caesar's assassination opened the final chapter in the crisis of the Roman Republic




