1. All renters/visitors required to register and apply for background check at the office. Show proof of age. Owners check-in and also leave departure date. Update your information.

2. Permit required for overnight parking in **designated** areas. Overnight street parking is not permitted.

Obtain permit at office (5-L) during office hours.

3. Speed Limit in park: 10 MPH. Be aware of other cars when parking on streets. They are very narrow. Emergency vehicles should be able to pass easily.

4. Check Clubhouse Activity Room # 1 for information on possible sales or rentals available.

- 5. Children must be accompanied by resident adult to use Pool & Clubhouse. All residents are to wear cover-up or Tee shirt when in clubhouse. DO NOT WALK INTO CLUBHOUSE WITH WET FEET!
- 6. SAFETY HINT: Use a FLASHLIGHT when walking during the dark hours after 6:00P. Golf Carts turn lights ON.

7. Residents should have Emergency Contact information in their office file, in case of medical problem or

weather emergency.

8. Any requests for our maintenance staff is to be submitted, IN WRITING, so work order can be generated. No verbal requests, please.

Pointe West Community Organizations

1. Residents Owned Community - ROC

- a. Residents who bought a share in community which owns the land. They display a black permanent tag on their coach.
- b. These residents pay real estate taxes to Pinellas County.

c. They pay a monthly maintenance fee to the ROC.

d. Organization elects residents to the Board to govern the running of Pointe West. These (9) directors elect yearly: a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.

2. Recreation Association - REC

- a. All residents are eligible to join, paying \$2.50 per person for life.
- b. It's managed by a Board of Directors (9) for rotating three year terms. They then elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer each year.
- c. They plan a Social calendar for winter and summer seasons.

3. Home Owners' Association - HOA

- a. Pointe West Homeowners Association Inc. A not-for profit corporation. The H.O.A. is by law, the official and legally recognized representative.
- b. Members Non-shareholders who rent their lots here regarding, rent increases, park rules and regulations, park amenities, state governing statutes.

4. Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc.

(FMO) 420 Portsmouth Rd., Largo, Florida (727)530-7539

a. Members – Florida manufactured homeowers.

b. Objectives – represents MFHO regarding state legislation And statutes in Florida.





Bazaar Donations: There are totes in Activity Room 1 for your smaller bazaar donations. Please do not just leave them helter-skelter in the clubhouse and please DO NOT leave large items. Call Kim Peterson 231-343-8742 for large item pick up. We accept furniture, kitchenware, clothing, games, jewelry, etc.



Office Reminder: Until further notice the office will be open on Monday through Friday from 9am to 2pm. If you wish to come to the office outside these hours please call to make an appointment (727) 584-8924.

Water Restrictions Reminder: The Southwest Florida Water Management District issued a modified Stage 1 Water Shortage for Pinellas County, effective December 1, 2023. Pointe West's designated day is Thursday, before 10am and after 4pm. Please adjust your watering schedule accordingly or you may receive a violation notice and be subject to fines. For more information, see https://pinellas.gov/watering-schedule-and-rules/.

Borrowing from the Clubhouse: Residents are reminded that if you wish to borrow chairs or tables from the Clubhouse you are required to sign for them. When you want to borrow items, please ask a REC member. The sign-up sheet is in the storage room which is normally locked and can be accessed by the REC board members. If there is a Clubhouse event planned (dance, park dinner, other events) you will not be authorized to borrow tables or chairs.

Yellow Directory (Dial Directory): Please contact Donna in the office and let her know of any changes or additions that you would like made. The office number is 727-584-8924, and is located at Lot 5-L.

Pool Umbrellas: If you open an umbrella at the pool, PLEASE close it before you leave. We don't want any umbrellas damaged by unexpected storms. If you use it and don't close it, you may be responsible if it gets broken.

When in the common spaces, or at the pool, please use proper receptacles for your cigarette butts. They are scattered over the sides of the roads and sidewalks. They not only present a fire hazard when a lit cigarette is flipped onto the ground, but it detracts from the beauty of our Park.

Bicycles and Golf Carts: Reminder - please park your bicycles and golf carts in the designated areas only and not on the walkways or in front of the doorways. There is a bicycle rack to the left of the main clubhouse door, and golf carts should park in parking spots. Please keep the sidewalk areas clear and hazard free.

If you are leaving the Park for an extended period please remember to notify the office. Make sure your 'out of the Park' address and phone number are current. Also inform the office who has a key to your unit, if you have authorized anyone to park in your driveway etc. Our community looks out for one another so it is important that information about your unit is current.

When Europeans first reached the Pinellas peninsula, the Tampa Bay area was inhabited by people of the Safety Harbor culture, divided into chiefdoms. One documented chiefdom in what is now Pinellas County was that of the Tocobaga, who occupied a town and large temple mound overlooking the bay in what is now Safety Harbor. The modern site is protected and can be visited as part of the County's Philippe Park, the oldest park in Pinellas County. The majestic shade trees and the Native American mound welcome visitors to the park. The Temple Mound (https://pinellas.gov/tocobaga-temple-mound/), built by the Tocobaga, is the largest remaining mound in the Tampa Bay region and is listed in the National Register of Historic Landmarks.



Memories drift like waves on an open sea always seeking emotions that make me, want to cry and thoughts that distort my mind and dreams that I let slip away



Celebrate Saint Patrick's Day

Happy St. Patrick's Day

Americans got involved. While the day is now associated with wearing green, parades and beer, the holiday is grounded in history that dates back more than 1,500 years.

The Real St. Patrick Was Born in Britain, not Ireland. Historians believe that St. Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland, was born near the end of the 4th century. At sixteen, he was kidnapped by Irish raiders and sold as a slave to a Celtic priest in the area now known as Northern Ireland. After toiling for six years as a shepherd, he escaped back to Britain, and eventually returned to Ireland as a Christian missionary.

There Were No Snakes Around for St. Patrick to Banish from Ireland. Legends say that St. Patrick stood atop an Irish hillside and banished snakes from Ireland—prompting all serpents to slither away into the sea. But research suggests snakes never occupied the Emerald Isle. There are no signs of snakes in the country's fossil record and water has surrounded Ireland since the last glacial period. Before that, the region was covered in ice and would have been too cold for the reptiles.

Leprechauns Are Likely Based on Celtic Fairies. The red-haired, green-clothed little guy associated with St. Patrick's Day was called "lobaircin," meaning "small-bodied fellow." Belief in leprechauns stems from Celtic belief in fairies—tiny men and women who could use their magical powers to serve good or evil. In Celtic folktales, leprechauns were cranky souls, responsible for mending the shoes of the other fairies.

The Shamrock Was Considered a Sacred Plant. Called the "seamroy" by the Celts, it symbolizes the arrival of spring. According to legend, St. Patrick used the plant as a visual guide when explaining the Holy Trinity. By the 17th century, the shamrock had become a symbol of emerging Irish nationalism.

The First St. Patrick's Day Parade Was Held in America. While people in Ireland had celebrated St. Patrick since the 1600s, the tradition of a St. Patrick's Day parade began in America. A St. Patrick's Day parade was held on March 17, 1601, in a Spanish colony in what is now St. Augustine, Florida. The parade and a St. Patrick's Day celebration a year earlier were organized by the Spanish Colony's Irish vicar Ricardo Artur. More than a century later, homesick Irish soldiers serving in the English military marched in Boston in 1737 and in New York City on March 17. Enthusiasm for the St. Patrick's Day parades in New York City, Boston and other early American cities only grew from there.

Corned Beef and Cabbage Was an American Innovation. While ham and cabbage were eaten in Ireland, corned beef offered a cheaper substitute for impoverished immigrants. Irish Americans living in the slums of lower Manhattan in the late 19th century and early 20th purchased leftover corned beef from ships returning from the tea trade in China. The Irish would boil the beef three times—the last time with cabbage—to remove some of the brine.
