Subject: Monthly Activity Report: January 2024



County Sewer Project: Pinellas County sent the board a draft agreement and easement for the proposed sewer replacement project. The board has concerns over several clauses in the agreement and in the easement. The board as met with our legal counsel as well as other parks involved in the project. All parties share similar concerns. The board has requested a meeting with our local councilman and the project leadership to discuss our concerns. As soon as the board receives clarification on the issues, the board will schedule a meeting with the shareholders to present the details of the agreement and the board recommendation going forward.

If the park does not agree to proceed with the county project, LSR will have to obtain a private sewer permit from the county. Our sewer system may not pass the county inspection and may require repair or updating. The board is preparing a plan that includes the actions required to pass the county requirements that is intended to minimize any impact to the shareholders. This plan will have to be coordinated with the county sewer permitting authority.

2024 Budget: The board conducted a budget review on January 22, 2024, in the hall. About seventy (70) shareholders were present. The board is recommending a 6.52% maintenance fee increase along with a onetime assessment equal to one additional month's maintenance fee to replace reserve funds (assessed in June).

There will be at least one additional budget question and answer meeting on February 5 in the hall.

Hall: The hall wiring was updated to current code. Necessary upgrades were found when the hall was inspected for insurance purposes.

The hall floor was stripped and waxed in January. This was required because the hall floor was cleaned with dish detergent and stripped the coating on the hall floor. Only specific cleaners can be used on the hall floor.

Hall reservations must be completed in the office. If any shareholder wishes to use the hall there is a written permission that must be received and a checklist for closing and cleaning that must be returned to the office. This requirement is for all events in the hall. The board has experienced some conflicts in scheduling.

Spa: New jets have been installed in the spa. The electrical system has also been updated. The board submitted a request for an updated permit to allow nighttime use.

Pool: A heater for the pool is still offline. Symbiont is scheduled to repair the heater in early February. The grates in the deep end of the pool were replaced as required by the state.

Utilities: LSR electric usage was up about 8% in 2023 but the cost was down by 2.3%. This included the fourmonth outage in the hall. Water consumption was up 10% in 2023 but 3% of this was due to potable water being used to "top-off" the pool. The board is looking into a

methodology to identify and locate water leaks early and repair these leaks in a timely manner. In addition, the board is soliciting volunteers to go house to house checking for leaks. Leaks inside homes raise our water and sewer bills. These leaks are the responsibility of the individual homeowner. The board recommends that if a homeowner is away for more than one week, the water to the home should be shut off and the hot water heater shut off as well.

LSR Tools: Tools have been taken from the maintenance shed and have not been returned or have been returned broken. The board has instituted a policy that any tool borrowed from LSR must be signed out and returned in clean, working order.

Maintenance:

- One of the two front air conditioners in the hall has failed and will need to be replaced. This expense will be covered by reserves.
- Tree trimming will take place in February.
- Matthews lawn service has now been cancelled. LSR has purchased equipment to cut and trim the lawns. This in-house lawn care is intended to save money for the shareholders in the future. The board has received some safety tips from a couple shareholders regarding the lawn cutting. Thank you for your suggestions.
- There is broken concrete on the sidewalk by the pond dumpster. This was caused by large trucks servicing the trash bins. The board is working to repair the broken sidewalk. Please be cautious when walking on or near the broken concrete.
- Fire extinguishers in the hall and office area are being replaced in preparation for our fire inspection.

New Employee: The board hired a new employee, Chris Cline, as assistant maintenance man. Chris will be cutting the lawn, cleaning, and generally helping around the park.

Front Fountain: A couple of shareholders have suggested the front fountain be removed and replaced with a new entrance. This requires a discussion amongst all shareholders and will be one of the topics for an upcoming town hall.

Boats in Common Dock Area: All boats moored along the cove on the common dock area must be registered in the office. In order to make sure the shareholders are properly protected, all boat owners who use the common dock area will be required to supply insurance information or indemnify the park for any damage caused to the common dock area due to negligence of the boat owner. Boat owners who use the common dock area will be contacted by Judy Flynn soon.

Social Committee Members: Tom Baker and Paul Reynolds have joined the Social Committee. Welcome!

AGM: The Annual General Meeting (AGM) is scheduled for 20 March 2024 at 7:00 pm in the hall. The first letter of notification of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) was sent out mid-January. If you did not receive it either via email or paper copy, contact Bill Smith at lsrsecy2@ gmail.com or call 716 361-7555.

Board of Directors Positions: Four (4) positions on the board are up for election at the next AGM. This is the opportunity for any shareholder in good standing to significantly contribute to the park. To be included in the election, you MUST send your written intention to run for the board to Bill Smith, lsrsecy2@gmail.com, on or before 9 February 2024. If you have not notified

Bill, in writing, by this date, you will not be eligible to run for the board.

New Owners Meet and Greet: A new owners "meet and greet" will be held on 29 February 2024 in the hall. All new owners are encouraged to attend. The board members will be there to answer any questions you may have.

Financial: The financial reports for December and for 2023-year end are posted in the hall. A year end audit is in process for 2023 and should be available for the AGM.

Board and Town Hall Meetings: A board meeting was held on 15 January 2024 in the hall. Minutes of this meeting were sent via email blast and are posted in the hall. The next board meeting will be held in early March. A second budget Q&A meeting will be held in the hall after coffee on Monday, 5 February 2024. Two town hall meetings are planned on the 19th and 26th of February 2024. One of these town halls will be dedicated to the county water project and the other for all other discussions. The subject matter depends on the county supplying information to the board in a timely manner. The sewer discussion will take precedence and will be brought before the shareholders at the earliest opportunity.

- 6. During and After a Storm Information on cleanup after the storm.
- 7. Disaster Assistance Information on insurance claims and FEMA

It is very important that any resident requiring assistance for evacuation, register on the "Special Needs" site. It is the only way that the County will be aware of their needs whether it is medical, mobility, or transportation, etc.
