use the facility, so parking there if you are not using the facility is plain rude. The Rules and Regulations state that you must park in your designated space (your carport) or find alternate parking outside Teakwood Village or from a neighbor with written permission. Parking on the street/sidewalks is not only specifically not allowed per the Rules and Regulations, but it is dangerous. You are blocking the view around corners, forcing anyone walking off the sidewalks and into the street and you could be blocking Emergency and Police from being able to get to someone in need. Imagine that is you and they can't get to you because of street parking.

Poo being left in yards, on sidewalks or in the street is nasty. Clean up after your pet. It is unsanitary and disrespectful to leave it. Also, if someone asks you to not let your dog in their yard, don't let your dog in their yard. Easy as that.

Now about guests. We ask you to register your guests, so we know who is supposed to be here and who is not. This is not complicated and only takes a few minutes. We all know how to follow rules, but I keep hearing of people who feel that the rules are for everyone else. They are for EVERYONE! Please be kind.

It will not be long before some of our neighbors start the migration north for the summer. I would like to ask everyone to remember Hope Villages of America (RCS Food Bank) as they clean out their cupboards. There are 2 large black barrels at the back of the Aloha Clubhouse. If you have any non-perishable food items you are not taking with you, please place them in the bins. This is a difficult time of year for Pinellas County food banks so your donations will be greatly appreciated.

I have been asked by several people who coordinate weekly activities at the clubhouses to ask residents to be respectfull of their pre-scheduled time. Too often people come in to get things out of the storage areas making quite a racket, to organize or remove things from the library area, work in the kitchen or just hang out and watch TV in the back area at a volume that is very distracting. Please check your monthly calendar in the newsletter before planning a time to work in the clubhouses. Remember, these are pre-approved and scheduled activities. Most only last 1 to 2 hours and it should be easy to schedule around them. You may think it is no big deal, but it is to those trying to participate in an activity.

Another subject discussed at the February Social Club meeting was the disregard of some residents in the rules that have been established for reserving tables for special events. Only those people who have signed up to help are allowed early reservations. All others must wait until noon to reserve seats. That DOES NOT mean coming in at 10:00 - 11:00 am, camping out at a table, and at the stroke of noon put names on that table. Because of the abuse, we will be checking the hall on the day of the event and anyone staking out tables in advance will be asked to leave and return at noon. If you wish the perk of early reservations then you need to sign up to volunteer.





Several minutes after we were seated we asked for menus, not knowing you have to go to the counter to place your order. For you Seinfeld fans I am sure you are familiar with the "Soup Nazi", well the owner of Sardo's is the equivalent in the pizza eatery world. At first we were somewhat taken aback by his confrontational attitude, but he threw in enough humor to make us realize it was all in fun. We ordered a variety of items, cold sandwiches, hot sandwiches, penne with meatballs, lasagna, eggplant, salads and of course pizza. Everything was delicious...equal to meals I have had in Williamsburg & Flatbush (neighborhoods in Brooklyn). One thing I highly recommend is the homemade Sardo bread for any sandwich you might order. If you like salad, it is nice that they offer small and large portions for most of them. Even a "small salad" is quite large, and all of the prices are very reasonable. After our meals were served Santo came by to check on us and was charming and just as sweet as could be. Since it was our first time there, he treated us all to a "Brookie" which is a layered mix of chocolate chip cookie and a brownie. Oh my goodness... it was soooooo good.

When we arrived, there were 4-5 customers. When we left an hour later there was a line of customers from the counter to the door waiting to place their orders and many of the tables/booths were already occupied. It is obvious that Super Sardo's Pizza has a loyal following... I saw a couple of Seminole firefighters in line. Hope you all take the time to try out this "Hidden Gem" and support our local merchants.
