FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

s I promised at this week's HOA Board of Directors meeting, I had a series of issues and questions to work out with our Murex management team. Below you will find answers to the issues we discussed.

- Replacement of vertical blinds on the windows and sliding glass doors. Murex is currently involving its Design Team to pick out a suitable blind to replace the previous ones. The problem is that all the brackets that held the previous blinds came up missing.
- Front door automatic opener. They have had several different companies come in and look at the operation of the front door opener. Murex has selected a contractor that stated they could fix this issue and it should be operational by March 18th.
- **Install stage lighting for use by entertainment groups**. Murex has purchased a mirrored ball for the dance floor and lighting will have to be installed to accent the ball. Prior to installation, electrical outlets need to be installed in the ceiling along with switches on the walls. At that time additional lighting can be installed to highlight the stage area.
- Get Spectrum Community Channel 732 up and running. Management recently purchased a laptop PC to use for loading information to the channel. Sandy will be assigned this duty, and it should be up and running in the near future. Along with this information source, your HOA is in the process of developing a website that will contain all the information you will ever need as to what is going on, now, tomorrow and in the future. We are meeting with the Website Developer this week and I will report back to you as to when this new feature will be ready for you to log in and enjoy.
- **Bingo**. This last week while cleaning up the storage room to bring back all the totes that were relocated off site during the renovations, I discovered that someone stole the Laptop PC out of our Bingo machine that held the programs to conduct Bingo. The Bingo package was purchased by the former CoOp spending thousands of dollars. Murex now is offering to bring in a new Virtual Bingo system that they have put in other communities. We are hoping that this will happen soon and if so, we will start Bingo up, if only for our Residents to break in the new system and give us a chance to get trained on its use.
- **Telephone for Pool Emergencies.** I have not been to the Clubhouse yet today, but the new landline phone should be installed and operational today.
- Tables & Clock for Pool Area. This has been put out to the Design Team to pick out the tables and find a fashionable clock for the pool area. They stated that the tables have been purchased and should be here soon. We have also requested that an appropriate clock be located in the Clubroom.
- Additional Lighting in Golf Cart Parking Area. This is being looked into along withcontinued on page 6

adding yellow caution paint around the cement pad outside the new side doors leading into the parking area. We feel this is a hazardous area and needs immediate attention.

- **Muscovy Ducks**. As many of you know, the duck population has exploded in our community. I have contacted a Wildlife firm that would come in and remove the ducks in a safe manor. I gave the bid to management for their input and will get back to you as to when and if this can be accomplished.
- **Murex Annual Payment to HOA**. This is an ongoing issue and will have to be worked out with Murex upper management. This annual payment was part of the Agreement sign by the Co-Op, your HOA and Murex upon sale of the community. I will get back to you when I hear from Murex Headcounter's in Fort Meyers.

Designed by Eugene Polley, an engineer at Zenith Electronics in the USA, the "Zenith Flash-Matic" remote control was the first wireless remote control for TV sets. It worked by pointing a



directional torch flashlight, looking a lot like a sci-fi ray gun, at four photocells, one in each corner of the television set. This enabled the user to turn the picture and sound on and off, as well as to turn the channel tuner dial clockwise and counter-clockwise. 
