The Florida Legislature for 2024 has been in session. In the final week of the session, we had success in two FMO sponsored bills that have made it to the Governor's desk. When he signs, it will be a good thing for all MHP and Condo Associations. The bills *continued on page 11*





will assist owners in dispute and mediation to have a timeline for decisions to be made. It also clarifies the background checks that must be made when a resident requires a live-in health aide, and that the aide will not have a right of tenancy when assistance is no longer needed.

The Tie-down program and the relocation of homes were in jeopardy when the state wanted to move them into the Division of Condominiums, Timeshares and Mobile Home administration. This agency was already overwhelmed and understaffed and if one or two big parks closed, a real crisis would have been created.

We know that final language in presented bills is always a part of getting something accomplished. Each side must give a little to succeed in the passage. With the FMO always on watch for us, we will continue to enjoy our lifestyle!






