### FROM THE OFFICE

am writing this article after I came home from another successful food event. First, I want to thank my group of people who helped make this possible. We all work well together, and, when needed, all I have to do is ask and most people are more than happy to help. Secondly, please mention to me when you come in if you are picking up some items for someone else in the park...if you are, that's ok, but it's the same rules, limit of 1 item (especially meat)! I usually announce when we have an abundance of a particular fruit or vegetable, where you can take extra. Third, please do not take extra food to throw in your backyard to feed the wildlife! I know you are just trying to be nice, but some of the wildlife in the park needs to go home! I have a raccoon as big as a toddler that comes just past dusk and makes himself very comfortable on our golf cart....I am sure if we left the key in it, he would drive it away. We never leave food out, and when we feed the squirrels and birds it is just enough for them to eat in a few hours while we are watching them. For those of you who are now thinking "she's crazy".....which may be true....but we have possums, armadillos (who are digging land mines in some yards), squirrels, otters as they travel from one body of water to another, Muscovy ducks (dirty and disease carrying), mallard ducks, rabbits (who make nests in your flower bed and have babies), rats....who are the absolute worst vermin that are not welcome (however, they don't read signs, just come where the food is). Don't say I forgot feral cats, because the roaming cats in this park are far from feral! Look how fat they are, and very rarely do you see one that is mangy looking. Pinellas County unfortunately offers a free spay/neuter program; if a resident takes a litter of kittens to them, they fix them and then they must be returned to the same place they came from. Fortunately for me, I live on a street where a resident did this....how do you think I feel about cat paw prints on my new car? We need to learn to cohabitate with them, while not doing anything to encourage them to overstay their welcome!

Rent checks......if you want to be sure we have received your rent check, bring it in during office hours so you can hand it to us. We cannot answer the phone when you call to see if we received your check! We receive 400 checks a month, 75% in the first 5 days. We have other things to do, so they are not immediately processed and deposited into the bank, and it also depends on which day of the week the 1st falls on for us to receive them. Plus, Joelle and I have a "checks and balance" system to ensure that all checks received are processed. One of us empties the mailbox every day during the first week of the month so it doesn't overflow. I do all the bank deposits from home, as there is just not enough time to do it during office hours. I am ok with that, because I would rather have residents stopping by to say hi or ask questions about things in the park rather than listen to the Embassy Hotline. It is usually around the 20th of the month when I do an audit to see if someone has forgotten to pay (It happens, we are all getting older). If it is an honest mistake, I even waive the late fee. Just a reminder, the late fee is a flat \$30, not prorated by how many days it's late!

The Homeowner's Association has appointed the rent committee for this year. It is chaired

by Paul Latuga and the other members are Joyce Latuga, David Howard, Mike Matheny, and Angela Robinson. Per Fl Statutes, Mr. Larson is only required to meet with a Committee of five people, but between now and September you can talk to anyone on the rent committee about any concerns you may have. Keep in mind this is not a "demand" meeting, it is just to make sure that the rent increase falls under the guidelines that are set forth in your prospectus. Mr. Larson does listen to any concerns they may have regarding things in the park (roads, trees, replacing me, etc.).

If you plan to leave for any period of time, you need to notify the office. This is for safety reasons, not because I care about where you are going! You also need to notify the office ahead of time if you have family coming to use your mobile in your absence. This is limited to family, as I do not want Embassy to start having the problems that VRBO and other rental agencies encounter. If they have a dog, it must be pre-approved and shot records provided. I will tell people to leave if these rules are not followed. It is for the safety of the elderly residents in the park that all guests are checked in properly.

We are still under Pinellas County water restrictions, which means that the only day you are supposed to water is Tuesday. Park rules limit car washing to twice a week, FOR RESIDENTS ONLY! Three times this past week I have seen "guests" washing their cars....guess who is paying for the water? There is a car wash two blocks west, right on East Bay, and they use reclaimed water to lower the impact on water usage. They even offer monthly subscriptions for unlimited washes.

As "snowbirds" get ready to leave, or residents go north for a month or so, remember to make sure your carport and lot are "hurricane" ready. This means that all ladders are secured, furniture is put inside, hanging plants are taken down, etc. Nothing should be laying around that can be blown around by 35-50 mile-an-hour winds. We get these gusting winds without a tornado even being around.

After April 15th I will be devoting a lot of time to "park rides" where I will be checking all mobile homes and carports. I will be looking for many things, but especially: refrigerators on carports that are not locked or hidden from road view; old appliances stored on the carport; ladders unsecured; mold on the shed and mobile home; peeling or old paint; household furniture on your carport; weeds anywhere around your mobile home; overgrown trees; cracked windows; ripped or old window coverings, screen rooms with boxes piled in them; just to name the most obvious violations. A lot of these are Largo City Code Ordinance violations, for which you can be fined (last I knew, fines started at \$140 and went up from there). The cleanest I have ever seen the park, and the way it should be kept, was when everyone prepared for the last hurricane that came close to us. Take a little pride in where you live; I do not like to write these letters; all residents have been provided with the Park rules that spell out the expected standards for living here.

Last but not least, come join us for the Neighborhood Watch meetings; they are the last
