MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

or your information, the Board has now engaged Converged Services, Inc. to solicit competitive proposals to address Palm Hill's needs for telecommunication services. We look forward to reviewing them and, once evaluated, they will be made available for shareholders' comments. The final step will be to seek Board support to move forward, ensuring that we procure services that meet our community's current and future needs.

All the Palm Hill Committees are presently busy with a host of projects, working towards delivering outcomes this year. I encourage everyone to follow matters of interest via Channel 732, web blasts, Zoom or in-person. E-mail addresses have been assigned to our Board and all Committees, which are available on both our website and the Palm Hill Link. Please feel free to avail yourselves of the opportunity to engage, submit questions, comments and suggestions.

LAND LEASE

Regarding the Land Lease Agreement, the Executive Committee of the Board has engaged our law firm to identify our legal counsel, the Taylor Family legal representative, and to assess and recommend a certified land appraiser in preparation for the December 15th, 2024 deadline. The Agreement and particulars of the stipulated 15-year reset are available in the Prospectus you were provided at orientation. If you need another copy, you may request it from our Office.

SANITATION FIELD

As a result of ongoing problems in the Sanitation Field, including constant misuse of the construction dumpster, it may be necessary to implement reduced hours of access. The issues are multi-faceted in nature (e.g. the completion of the Board-approved improvements to the Sanitation Field, difficulty in filling vacant maintenance positions, the rising costs of self-administration), which may necessitate that temporary restrictions are needed to prevent continued misuse (e.g. dumping of prohibited material such as paint, electronics, oil and tires) and to control costs. Please refer to Rules and Regulations VI (Q). Should the hours be reduced, it is expected to be temporary in nature and further clarity will be provided.

This is a busy time of the season as we all enjoy warmer weather and welcome relatives and friends visiting. Please be reminded to respect the quiet enjoyment of our neighbors and all our rules and regulations, in particular pool etiquette. Please make your visitors aware that we are all concerned with their best interests of health and safety while they enjoy our amenities.

PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 - Q:

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of material handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office shall be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.
