



IT'S THAT TIME OF THE YEAR AGAIN TO THINK ABOUT GETTING PREPARED FOR HURRICANE SEASON:

More information will be coming. Keep an eye on the Scuttlebutt, e-mail, facebook, and the weather channels.

BEING PREPARED FOR A HURRICANE:

Larricane season begins June 1st and ends November 30th, more or less. We in mobile homes are in the area known as ZONE A. This designation means we must evacuate from our homes when/if a hurricane is expected to come to our area. Evacuation may be to a friend's or relative's home in a safe zone, going North and or inland or to a designated shelter. If you require assistance with transport during the emergency, arrangements can be clarified through the citizen's information center 727-464-4333 PRIOR TO THE NEED. Forms will be available to be completed then submitted to appropriate people at the EOC. This number is only available once the hurricane threat is posted. Paper pamphlets are being printed and will be available.

To get updates on any storm it is suggested you sign up to receive emergency notifications by phone text or e-mail at www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas.

To find updates on preparedness before, during and after the storm sign-on at <u>www.</u> <u>pinellascounty.org/emergency</u>.

If you have a pet you can contact www.pinellascounty.org/animalservices.

Information on general preparedness and live updates during emergencies can be seen from the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and found on Spectrum 637, WOW! 18 or Frontier 44.

It's also time to be putting that **TO-GO-BOX together**, just in case.

12 essential items you need to pack: 1. 1 gallon of water per person per day. 2. Food, at least a 3 day supply of non-perishable with a can opener if you have canned foods. 3.



HERE'S WHAT'S COOKING:

Potato Pancake:

1 large potato (8oz) peeled and grated, ¼ coup onion, ¼ tsp kosher salt, ¼ cut starch, ¼ cut grape seed oil (or vegetable oil).

Put grated potato and onion in a bowl. Add salt, potato starch and mix it together. Heat a 9 to 12 inch nonstick pan over medium-high heat. Add 2 tablespoons grape seed oil and swirl the pan around to coat it evenly. Add the potato mixture and spread it thinly on the pan. Cook a few minutes until the bottom of the pancake turns crispy, and light golden brown. Turn it over with a spatula or flip it. Add the rest of the grape seed oil to the edge of the pancake. Shake the pan and tilt it so that oil spreads underneath the pancake. Let it cook until the bottom of the pancake turns golden brown. Keep turning it over and cooking until both sides are crispy and light golden brown, usually about 8 to 10 minutes. Transfer to a plate and serve hot with the sauce.

Dipping Sauce:

2 tablespoons soy sauce, 1 tablespoon freshly squeezed lime juice (or vinegar), j1 green onion, chopped, ½ cup thinly sliced onion, 1 jalapeno pepper, chopped, ½ teaspoon sugar.

Combine soy sauce, lime juice, green onion, onion, jalapeno pepper, and sugar in a bowl. Mix together until the sugar is melted. Set aside.

SKY WATCH

That is happening in the night sky this month? This month's action is concentrated in the eastern sky during dawn's twilight. On the 1st at around 5:15am, Saturn stands highest in the east, with Mercury below it and a dim, orange Mars halfway between them. On the 4th Saturn and Mars stand on opposite sides of the thin crescent Moon in the brightening twilight. Mars hovers to the upper right of the Moon on the 5th at 5:00am. On the 6th at 5:5am, an unobstructed view of the eastern horizon reveals Mercury to the lower right of the crescent Moon. On the evening of the 15th, the Moon is just above blue Spica, Virgo's brightest star. A gorgeous, super-close Saturn Moon conjunction unfolds from 4:30 to 5:00am on the 31st.


