

Treetings fellow RV residents. After some discussion, and a sampling of resident canvassing, it has been found that we have a need for a program to reach out to the residents in our community that are not able to get around and socialize.

We now have enough year-round residents to support a Care Network Program. What is this Program entail? Please read on:

RV NETWORK PROGRAM

<u>What is the need?</u> To provide near-daily contact (by phone call, text, visual of resident activity) with residents who have:

• Minimal mobility

CARD CLUB

• No local support

Evidence of need:

- Previous system of Good Morning/Good Evening signs are not reliable residents often forget to change the sign, so neighbors don't respond.
- Reports of neighbors who fall and are undiscovered for too long of a time.
- Report of undiscovered fatality in Ranchero Village.

Overview of the Program

- Volunteers will call, text, or do a face-to-face with shut-ins X# times weekly.
- Volunteers will be assigned to specific residents, who agreed to participate.
- A protocol for instances when the shut-in does not respond to a call, text, or face-to-face.
- Any face-to-face contact would be solely at the discretion of the volunteer and not an expectation of the program.



POLITICAL FLAGS AND SIGNS

s the political season is starting in the U.S., please remember that the prospectus states that no political flags or signs are to be displayed outside of your home. No matter which political party you are associated with, they cannot be displayed. They will have to be removed asap.

RECYCLED PAINT – Swap and Shop

You can take your leftover paint to the Pinellas recycling plant on Tuesdays through Fridays, from 7:30-4:30pm. They are also open the 1st and 3rd Saturday of every month from 7:00-5:00. The building's street address is: 2855 109th Ave. N, St. Petersburg. To get there from here, head east on Bryan Dairy (it changes to 118th St.), as far as you can go, turn right onto 28th St. N, then take the 3rd entrance to the recycling complex. The plant is huge, and the access road might be a little difficult to recognize. Here's the road sign you



should look for:

If you're just dropping off old paint, they have a Drive-Thru, but you will have to unload the paint yourself.

You can also go there to shop for paint that's been

left behind by local contractors. They buy in bulk and drop off what they can't use. Park your car instead of driving through, and walk into the facility and see if there's a color you like, (usually indicated by a smudge of paint on the lid). Take the can(s) you want, but the employees can't help you load your car.

NOTE #1: You will need a government issued ID with you (like a driver's license) to scan, proving that you're a Pinellas County resident.

NOTE #2: Employees can't help you unload or load your car. You must do that yourself.

Next month we will tell you where you can take your unwanted electronic devices.
