To facilitate communication, the Army Signal Corps worked tirelessly throughout the war installing and repairing telephone wire.

Initially, operators in Europe were (male) soldiers assigned to Army Signal Corps. They were not necessarily thrilled with this assignment, and they were not very good at it.

Accustomed to a high level of operator service in America (the U.S. and Canada), General Patton ascertained very early in his deployment that he needed Hello Girls in his service. He specified women of the highest competence and character who were fluent in English and French, so they could also serve as translators for French military speaking with Americans and British. At the time, women were allowed to serve in the military only as nurses, but Patton prevailed, resulting in the recruitment of six groups of women (over 200 in all) highly trained to use telephone equipment from the most antique to the most modern.

The novel "Hello Girls: America's First Women Soldiers" by Elizabeth Cobbs, published in 2017, is a long, easily read fictional account of several women who served in the Signal Corps Female Operators Unit. The main focus is the outstanding contribution they made to the war effort. The women could connect five calls in the time it took the men to connect one and proved invaluable to maintaining wartime communication.

By focusing on the daily lives of several women stationed at different bases, the novel is also able to include other issues of the day. For example, not everyone was in favor of women soldiers, which sometimes showed in their treatment. Yet their exemplary performance is considered a major reason for the passage of the 19th Amendment giving women the right to vote. The treatment of black soldiers is mentioned a couple of times, and the Spanish flu pandemic that gradually becomes an important complication to the war effort is well documented.

I learned quite a lot about WWI by reading this book and was grateful it was an easy read. The facts were interesting, but the story was a little bland. I would give it 3½ to 4 stars.

Did You Know

Ver visited a cemetery and noticed a splattering of items left on gravestones? From coins to flowers to stones, there's a sentiment behind why visitors leave certain pieces. And if you've ever noticed coins in particular on a headstone, you might be curious why. As it turns out, this act of remembrance is intended to honor individuals who served this country through military service.



When you see coins on a gravestone, this signifies that the person buried there was a member of the military. Similar to gold stars on license plates, these coins are a meaningful way for people to convey their pride in a loved one who is no longer with them. People who visit the deceased service member can leave a coin on the headstone so when loved ones come to the cemetery, they're aware that others have been to pay their respects, too. This moving sentiment can make a



tremendous impact on the family of deceased military folks, which is why it's a special tradition.

It's also important to take note of the type of coin on the stone. For instance, different coins hold different meanings.

As you may have guessed, the different coins have different associations. If you notice a quarter on a headstone, for instance, the past visitor is trying to convey something different than if they'd left a penny. Let's walk through what the individual coin types mean.

If you notice a penny on a gravestone, this signifies that a person has visited the headstone. It's an act of gratitude for the person's service. Anyone can leave a penny, whether they are a family member, friend or fellow service person.

If there is a nickel on the gravestone, this means that the visitor who left it went to boot camp with the person buried.

Next, if you see a dime on their gravestone, that signifies that the visitor served with the deceased military member.

Seeing a quarter has a particularly heavy association. If you notice a quarter, this signifies that a previous visitor was present when the soldier passed away.

Now that you understand what each coin means when you see it, you'll have a better idea of what it means when you see this emotional item left behind at a gravestone. And more importantly, you'll know the proper way to leave a coin.

EASY CHOCOLATE CRESCENTS – JUST 4 INGREDIENTS

Ingredients

- 8 ounces refrigerated crescent rolls 8 crescents
- 1 teasoon ground cinnamon
- 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
- ½ cup mini chocolate chips
- powdered sugar optional

Instructions


- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F.
- 2. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- 3. Gently open the can and unroll the crescents. Gently separate the crescent rolls.
- 4. Combine sugar and cinnamon in a small bowl.
- 5. Sprinkle about a half a teaspoon of the cinnamon-sugar mixture on top of each crescent.
- 6. Sprinkle 1 tablespoon of mini chocolate chips on top and gently press into the crescent roll.
- 7. Roll up the crescent roll and pinch the seam closed.
- 8. Bake for 10 to 12 minutes or until golden brown.
- 9. Sprinkle with powdered sugar if desired.

Two tips:

- Use mini chocolate chips. Then ensures they melt completely and even though they retain their shape, I love that melted chocolate on the inside. If you have only regular sized chocolate chips you can either chop them up a bit... Or not. Totally up to you.
- Press the chocolate chips into the crescent roll so they are "stuck" there. That way when you roll the crescents up, they don't scatter all over the place.
