

HISTORY OF THE MAHAFFEY

ocated in the heart of beautiful Downtown St. Petersburg, the Duke Energy Center for the Arts – Mahaffey Theater is a 2,031-seat cultural jewel featuring elegant ballroom space, spectacular waterfront views, and European box-style seating. Just steps away from the culturally vibrant Downtown and minutes away from white sandy beaches and world-famous museums,

The Mahaffey hosts top-quality national and international artists and performances–Broadway, classical, pop, rock, comedy, dance, family, and the renowned Florida Orchestra. Additionally, the theater supports the highly successful Class Acts program, which enables school children to experience the performing arts through in-theater performances as well as in-school outreach and extension programs.

The facility first opened in the Spring of 1965 as part of the Bayfront Center entertainment complex. It was first renovated in 1987-1988 and at that time was renamed The Mahaffey Theater for the Performing Arts, in recognition of the Mahaffey family who contributed significantly to the capital campaign.

In 2006, Progress Energy and the City of St. Petersburg announced a 20-year partnership to rename the space the Progress Energy Center for the Arts which would include the newly renovated Mahaffey Theater, The Center Plaza Waterfront Park, and would also eventually include the new home of the Salvador Dali Museum. In 2012, the theater was renamed the Duke Energy Center for the Arts.

Its beautiful setting, unparalleled entertainment and proximity to the lively downtown St. Petersburg area make Duke Energy Center for the Arts – The Mahaffey, THE live performance venue in the Tampa Bay area.

2024 GAO ANNUAL MEETING TREASURERS HIGHLITES

Pancake Breakfast, Bike Parade and Coffee Chat are regular monthly functions, have income and expenses, and are for the most part self-sustaining with Coffee Chat and Bike Parade receiving some support from the General Fund being supplied with beverages, plates and napkins.



Within the past year Ladies Day and the Show Choir have engaged in fund-raising and spending thus relieving the General Fund from supportive practices of the past. As a result, Santa Parade, Memorial Service, Ladies Day Crafting and the annual Gateway Show received minimal funding from the General Fund Account. Recognition goes to Roger Rex and the members of the Show Choir and to Marylynn Soehnlen and the ladies of Ladies Day for their efforts and results.

Dances and other activities receive and disburse money on an individual basis as authorized by the Steering Committee.

The General Fund receipts and expenses for GAO activities includes ticket sales and cost for entertainment involving Halloween Dance, New Years Party, Valentine Dance; ticket sales and supplies for Thanksgiving & Christmas Dinners, and; expenses for Bazaar Fund Raiser, Potluck Dinners, Dances and kitchen expenses for nearly all clubhouse use. Other expenses include miscellaneous purchases that are accounted for as 'Expenses' to the General Fund Account and can include food items, serving utensils; office supplies and other Steering Committee authorized spending.

Within this past year the Men's Pancake Breakfast receipts and expenses have been deposited and paid using the GAO Bank of America VISA debit card. Pancake Breakfast has traditionally been a profitable venture and been the sponsor for the Luau Dance and for various special GAO needs as they have arisen. The increases to cost for food and paper products did force a relatively modest increase to the breakfast meals. I mean really, \$4 for pancakes, eggs, sausage, apple sauce, orange juice and coffee. At the end of this season the Team will analyze whether the increase was sufficient to sustain the profit level that Pancake Breakfast hopes to achieve. At the close of the season I will present a financial report to the Men's Pancake Breakfast Team and at that time discuss future goals and options to achieve them.

All GAO activity accounts are well funded, and the General Fund is now 30% above the same time last year.




