

There are NO structures in Doral that are Shelter Rated and when/if Pinellas County initiates an Evacuation; ALL mobile homes are included in the order. Please keep in mind that in an Evacuation the Park Board/Management will shut off the main water valve leading into the park.

Check on the Doral Website under Emergency Prep for additional information about Evacuations, Shelters, Evacuation Routes and other important information.

- 1. Once again; DO NOT park vehicles (Autos & Golf Carts). on the grass around the park in addition to no parking on the streets overnight.
- 2. The parking at the Cottage and Clubhouse is limited to those vehicles with VISITOR tags during overnight hours. You are likely to be towed, at your expense.
- 3. A reminder that no one wearing diapers or swimmers are allowed in the pool. If they need to wear them it is NOT okay to take them off to be in the pool as accidents can happen. Please help us maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of the pool.
- 4. Those of you that are in need of a Handicap Tag for your Golf Cart:
  - a. Doral Handicap Stickers are available at the office.
  - b. The cost is \$1.00. They are ONLY for Golf Carts.

c. You will need to present a State Handicap Hanger or State Handicap License Plate to get one. (Can be from out of state for snowbirds).

- d. They are for use by the Handicap person only.
- 5. Your Doral Board wishes all of our Seasonal Residents and Owners safe travels to wherever you are headed to escape from our somewhat hot and humid summers. We look forward to welcoming you back in the fall.




