

From the Board of Directors

That the summer heat upon us, it is important that as we go to the pool to get a little relief from the heat we comply with the rules that allow us to keep our pool open. These rules are in your Blue Book, and you should take a few minutes to review them before your

guests arrive. Of the rules that are there, the one that will cost us all the most money in the long run is the wearing of tanning lotions and oils, which are prohibited from being used inside the pool. These substances will destroy our pool filters and require a very costly replacement. We ask that you please remind your guests.

Each of you that stay in Blue Jay during hurricane season should have an emergency plan that includes: 1. where you will stay if there is an evacuation; 2. supplies for 2-5 days; 3. medications; 4. important papers to take; 5. medical and pet accommodations. A reminder, the clubhouse cannot be used as an emergency shelter. You should also remember that: a. If you choose to stay Emergency Services will not come to help you once the wind speed reaches 45 mph; b, The Association will turn off the water in the park; and c. mobile homes are not built to survive hurricane speed winds. Keep this in mind as hurricane season approaches. It could save your life.

This is a quick reminder to follow up on a previous post, as our trash company is under new management and the rules have changed a bit. We have been asked by our trash collectors to ask residents to place larger items out for disposal on Fridays rather than Tuesdays. We are being told that the truck is emptier when they get to Blue Jay on Fridays. Also, the trash collectors have been directed not to remove any item – including a trash can – that exceeds 50 pounds in weight.

Please remember that there are guidelines in the Blue Book that reference putting trash on the sidewalk. Trash in cans can be put out after 6 PM the night before, but trash in bags or bound by string or rope cannot be on the sidewalk before the morning of pickup.

Issues are developing relative to homeowners starting projects on their home without Architectural Committee approval. The purpose of approval is to ensure that changes conform to our documents. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to obtain approval. Without approval you could be required to remove all changes and restore the property to its pre-work state. Do not let contractors begin work on your homes before getting approval. Not doing so could prove very costly.

Finally, Blue Jay policies, and Pinellas County ordinances, prohibit parking on our sidewalks. We have received complaints from residents who use walkers. They cannot walk on sidewalks because automobiles are there. All motor vehicles, including golf carts, should be parked on the street or preferably in your driveway. You are responsible to ensure that contractors who are working at your home adhere to this restriction as well.



We have many new lady residents and every one of you are invited to join the Red Hot Mamas. If you have any questions, need a red hat or looking for a ride call me at 904-616-9142.




