



- Start bringing drinking water into your house. Plan for 1 gallon per person per day.
  Avoid shopping when a storm watch is issued. Get it now.
  - Shop for non-perishable food, 3 days of food is recommended. Avoid stocking up with PERISHABLE "buy one-get-one" items.
  - Find a place to store any outside grills, garbage cans & recycling bins before a storm approaches.
  - Lawn ornaments, flags, and plants should be picked up and stored. They will become dangerous projectiles during a story.
  - Have a plan to close your awnings or board up windows. Arrange to get help from a neighbor.
  - Have an evacuation plan in order a shelter, staying with a friend, or staying in a motel.
  - Take personal papers with you.
  - If our park sustains damage, keep an eye on the local news channel for re-entry information into our park.
  - Make sure your car has a FULL tank of gas.
  - Have CASH on hand, small bills.
  - Turn off your water at the meter.
  - Use common sense and stay safe.

#### **SKY WATCH:**

That is happening in the night sky this month?

On the 1st at 4:30am, look for the crescent Moon halfway between Saturn and Mars. Both planets share the same 1st-magnitude brightness. Due east on the morning of the 2nd and 3rd, Mars is the bright orange "star" near the Moon at 4:30am. After the 15th, Jupiter returns as a morning star due east at 4:30am. On the 30th, Mars hovers halfway between the crescent Moon and brilliant Jupiter, a sight best seen at around 4:45am. Summer in the Northern Hemisphere begins with the solstice on the 20th at 4:51pm EDT. This is the day when the Sun is highest at midday, rises at its leftmost position, and sets at the year's rightmost spot on the horizon.

June Moon manes: June's full Moon, the Full Strawberry Moon, got its name because the Algonquin tribes knew it as a signal to gather ripening fruit. It was often known as the Full Hoer Moon and the Full Hot Moon.






