

# **STAY SUN SAFE**

W ith summer right around the corner, we can expect warmer weather and longer brighter days. Keep in mind that while UV rays are their strongest between 10am and 4pm, active sun-safe practices are important all day long. If your shadow is shorter than you are, then you should seek shade.






