ear Fellow Residents:

Hurricane Season: Hurricane season is upon us. The National Hurricane Center has projected:

- 23 projected storms (average is 14)
- 11 hurricanes (7 is average)
- 5 major hurricanes (3 is average)

This means a VERY active season is expected. It is important for all shareholders and especially full-time residents to be prepared. Please make sure you update your emergency contact information with Judy Flynn (lsrdirector25@gmail.com).

Pinellas County Sewer Project: LSR received an updated sewer agreement from Pinellas County on 24 April 2024. This agreement was modified to incorporate all of the LSR Board's concerns including the easements and warranties. A board meeting was held on 29 April 2024 to accept and sign the agreement including the easements and warranties. The agreement was executed and mailed to the county by 30 April 2024.

Maintenance:

- The lift station pump timer was repaired.
- The air conditioner was installed in the hall.
- The pavilion roof was cleaned and sealed.
- Tree trimming was completed. The next tree trimming is scheduled for the fall.
- The faulty water fountain in the hall will be replaced soon.
- The pavilion shades are in a state of disrepair. To extend the life of the shades, the board and some members of the community are working to repair the shades with the long-term plan to replace the shades in the next 2-3 years.
- Some of the tables and chairs in the hall and around the pool need some repair. If you come across any furniture that needs repair, please identify these items and put them in an isolated area. Notify any board member of what you found.

Lake Weeds: There has been some concern regarding the weeds in the lake. The board shared the permit we are working under so residents can better understand the issues LSR is facing. Not all of the area along the lake is able to be sprayed and not all of the weeds can be sprayed. Our contractor works very hard to maintain control of the weeds and sprays at least once a month.

Long Term Plan: The board sent a draft of a long-term plan for the park to all residents who have an email registered with the park. We are looking for shareholders' feedback as well as volunteers to be on the Long-Term Planning Committee (to be formed).

Land Depression: The second land depression discovered in the park was repaired in April. This was a relatively minor repair. The major land depression has not yet been repaired. Permits are holding up this repair.

Trash: Please be mindful to not inundate the trash bins with construction materials. If you have a contractor, the contractor must dispose of the construction debris outside the park. Shareholders are allowed to put trash in the bins but please do not use-up any one bin with your debris. Be considerate of your neighbors.

Propane Tanks: The board has noticed that some propane tanks owned by individual shareholders are in a state of disrepair and could be a danger to the community. Propane tanks must be inspected and the inspection tags prominently displayed on the tank.

Pets: Kathy McQuisten-O'Dell is maintaining the pet registration log. This includes the updated pet license and shot records. Please make sure you send Kathy your updated information: lsrdirector24@gmail.com.

Trespassing: The board has received some complaints of trespassers in the park. When you see someone trespassing, please call the police. One bike (unlocked) was stolen.

Rentals: The board has received complaints about short term (less than 3 months) and **unregistered** renters in the park. Safety is our primary concern. There are specific rules regarding rentals in the park that have been in the books for several years. These rules are there to protect the residents and shareholders. At a town hall about 2-3 years ago, the majority of the attendees did not wish to change the rules regarding rentals and visitors. Please make sure you adhere to these rules and also make sure your approved renters sign in and sign out of the park.

Gator: The board attempted to have the large alligator taking up residence in the pond removed. Unfortunately, this is taking longer than we anticipated. Please make sure you take care around any fresh or brackish water in Florida. There are most likely to be alligators waiting for an opportunity to introduce themselves to you.

Tools: We continue to have tools missing or broken. As a result, the board has changed the locks on the maintenance shed. If any resident/shareholder wishes to use any tool in the maintenance shed, you must (each time) get board permission.

Informational Notes: A series of informational notes are planned to be sent to all shareholders with emails registered in the office. The first in the series was sent out in early May. Any suggestions you have are welcomed. Please contact either Steve Schaefer at lsrdirector12@gmail.com or Kathy McQuisten O'Dell at lsrdirector24@gmail.com.

Financial: The financial reports for April will be posted in the hall. The board has found the necessity to hire a parttime bookkeeper because the increase in accounts, bills, financial activity (due in part to an aging park) and the lack of volunteers with financial background and the willingness to work several hours per week on the LSR books. This should make future transitions of board members easier.

Board Meetings: A board meeting was held on 29 April 2024 to approve the Pinellas County Sewer Agreement and easements. Minutes for all board meetings were sent out via email.

SOME FUN FACTS ABOUT LAKE SEMINOLE

The first thing to note is that there are two Lake Seminoles in Florida. Our wonderful lake, and another that is located in the northern part of the state and crosses into parts of Alabama, Georgia, and Florida. The northern Lake Seminole is quite a bit bigger, at 37,000 acres, but both lakes are relatively shallow at less than ten feet deep.

Our Lake Seminole covers 684 acres with an average depth of just 5-6 feet, with the deepest channel at about 8 feet deep. The lake is just over three miles long and just over a half a mile wide. It is home to several species of fish, turtles, birds, and a 2023 alligator census counted 238 gators that were living in and around the lake. Prior to 1945, the lake area that we know today was an extension of Long Bayou, a brackish water segment of Boca Ciega Bay. In the 1930's local farmers experienced two terrible freezes in both 1934 and again 1935. The cold weather blanketed the area during a time when Long Bayou's shallow water did little to warm the nearby areas. After Lake Seminole Resort as seen from a these freezes, it was suggested by local farmers that a large lake would help to protect against the freezes, plus



boat out in the lake.

it would provide a source of fresh water to irrigate the orange groves and farms in the area. It could also be considered as a source for potable water for the growing residents of the area.

In 1945, Pinellas County moved forward with the creation of the lake in conjunction with the planned construction of Park Boulevard by the Florida State Public Roads Administration. The fresh water source for the lake is Long Creek which flows into the lake from the north. A weir (a low level spillway) was added to the bottom of the lake to control the water level. By the late 1970's the water quality in the lake had declined, so in 1971, the City of Largo wastewater plant was no longer permitted to discharge directly into Lake Seminole.

The Seminole Bypass Canal was created in 1976 to better control flooding and to improve the deteriorating water quality. It helped with the flood control, but the water quality saw little improvement. The storm water runoff into Lake Seminole had high levels of both Nitrogen and Phosphorus. These nutrients contributed to excessive growth of algae, as well as native and invasive plants, in the lake.

After several failed efforts to improve the water quality, the Regional Stormwater Retrofit Project was initiated in 2004. The plan was to build and operate several Alum water treatment plants around the lake. Construction of the first four plants began in 2004. Five such plants are in operation today. An Alum processing plant uses Alum (short for Aluminum Sulfate) to

treat the water entering, and in the lake. Alum water treatment is not new. It was used by the ancient Romans to treat water for drinking. When Alum is injected into stormwater it binds with suspended solids, metals, and phosphous and it forms aluminum phosphate and aluminum hydroxide precipitates. These precipitates, known as floc, settle out of the water column and are deposited on the lake bottom as a stable and inactive material. In recent years the lake has seen steady improvement. In fact, recent water quality analysis shows improvements in all water quality parameters for the lake. Lake Seminole was the only waterbody in Pinellas county that exhibited decreasing trends in all three categories tracked, which are total suspended solids (TSS), total Nitrogen (TN), and total Phosphorus (TP). Despite the improvements, the overall water quality rating is still considered 'Fair', but continued improvements may have the lake on the path to a 'Good' rating.

FRIDAY, JUNE 14th 2024 IS FLAG DAY IN THE USA

hen the American Revolution broke out in 1775, the colonists were not fighting united under a single flag. Instead, most regiments participating in the war for independence against the British fought under their own flags. In June of 1775, the Second Continental Congress met in Philadelphia to create the Continental Army—a unified colonial fighting force—with the hopes of a more organized battle against its colonial oppressors. This led to the creation of what was, essentially, the first "American" flag, the Continental Colors. On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the Articles of Confederation and passed a resolution stating that "the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white," and that "the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation." Over 100 years later, in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary of that decree by officially establishing June 14 as Flag Day. Canada has its own Flag Day celebrated on February 15 of each year. At the stroke of noon on February 15, 1965, Canada's red and white maple leaf flag was raised for the very first time on Parliament Hill. On the same day in 1996, National Flag of Canada Day was declared.

PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

The Atlantic hurricane season begins June 1 and ends November 30 of each year. Historically in Florida, the most active time for hurricane development is mid-August through mid-October.

Pinellas County Emergency Management offers a free emergency notifications service, called Alert Pinellas that will send an email and/or a text to you to let you know about imminent severe weather. You can sign up for emergency notifications at https://pinellas.gov/alert-pinellas You will need to establish a user name and a password for this site, but it is friendly and is easy to navigate. Both year-round residents and Snowbirds may sign up for this service. The site will not send out routine weather reports, but it will contact you when extreme weather is approaching our area. This includes tornado warnings, hurricane or tropical storm warnings, and any other weather event that may require residents to seek shelter or evacuate.





The story of the mustard seed

In a far away land, lived a young woman and her name was Kisagotami. Now this young woman had only one son—and she loved him with all her heart. But one day her beloved boy fell sick and, despite all the young mother's efforts to save



him, he tragically died. The young mother was so distraught at her loss that she was not able to accept the death and loss of her son, and so desperately, the young mother approached each one of her friends and begged them, "Please, save my child." But each one of her friends said the same thing: "Kisagotami, dear one, the child is dead. There is nothing now that can save him."

But the grieving mother refused to accept her friends' well-meaning words. Instead she carried her child to the Buddha. Weeping uncontrollably, Kisagotami said, "Please save my child. Please give me some medicine that will cure him."

Buddha looked at the woman with compassion and wisdom, he told the young mother that he would make a medicine for the child, but to do so the Buddha would need some special ingredients—among the things the Buddha said he would need was a handful of mustard seed.

However, the Buddha gave the young mother some special instructions for procuring the mustard seeds: "You must get the mustard seeds from a household where not one of its inhabitants has died—parent, child or servant."

And so the aggrieved mother set out to accomplish the task. She went from house to house in the hope that she would find just such mustard seed as the Buddha desired for the medicine. And every person she spoke to very gladly offered her the seed in the hope that it would save the child's life. But each time the seed was offered and Kisagotami asked whether anyone had died in the house, she found that every single household had suffered just such a loss. At the first house she stopped at, it was the husband who had died. At the second house she stopped at, it was a daughter who had died. And at the third, it was an old grand—mother. Kisagotami could not find one household that had escaped suffering.

Very sadly, Kisagotami returned to the Buddha and very, very gently she laid her child's body on the ground, and said, "I understand now what you and the others were trying to tell me.

The compassionate Buddha said, "You thought you were alone in your suffering. But it is the nature of life that no one can escape the suffering of impermanence."

- 6. During and After a Storm Information on cleanup after the storm.
- 7. Disaster Assistance Information on insurance claims and FEMA

It is very important that any resident requiring assistance for evacuation, register on the "Special Needs" site. It is the only way that the County will be aware of their needs whether it is medical, mobility, or transportation, etc.
