


# From the Manager's Desk

ear Down Yonder,

I would like to address some concerns regarding the pool area at Down Yonder:

### **SWIMMING POOL:**





### Per the posted rules at the pool:

Rule # 7 states the following: Food, Alcoholic Beverages & glass containers are prohibited in the pool area.

(\*) There is also a separate sign which reads as follows: NOTICE - No Alcoholic beverages allowed in pool area.

### **Per the Community Rules:**

No food or drink is allowed in the pool area except on the patio, this does not mean alcoholic drinks. (For Clarification: The patio is the covered area located on the blue carpet.)

### **SMOKING AT THE POOL:**

For the smokers at Down Yonder, there is a designated smoking area on the pool deck which is clearly marked and located on the west side of the pool. Smoking is to take place in this area "ONLY" or you must leave the pool area to smoke.

The covered patio area (blue carpet) is a "NO SMOKING" area. Recently management discovered fresh new cigarette burn holes in the blue carpeting of this area which appeared after the Halloween party.



### **SITE CLEAN UP:**

Management has been conducting 360 Inspections with a strong emphasis on the following:

- 1. Cluttered Carports
- 2. Items being stored around the home.

Management will be focusing on other items, but the main focus will be cluttered carports and home sites. Please ensure your homesite is not a storage area.



When you receive a notice, please act and please do not sit on your hands and do nothing.

# Is your ice cream feeling a little warm?

The two substances in ice cream that are usually varied are the amount of fat and air that are incorporated. According to On Food and Cooking: The Science and Lore of the Kitchen by Harold Mc-Gee, "ice cream is a foam that is stabilized by freezing much of the liquid." So if you've ever bought an ice cream that seems a bit warmer and fluffier than other versions you've had, the reason is probably because the brand you've bought is cheaper and incorporates more air. What this means is that the sensation of coldness is lessened because there is less ice and less icy solution because more air has been added to the frozen foam mixture.

Another thing that can happen is that fat content can be reduced in a brand. This can in reverse fashion result in a product that feels colder. This is because the fat globules are not present to break up the ice crystals. Often this also produces a grainy, ice-flecked texture to the brand—think ice milk and sherbet products.
