COVER STORY: HEART SAVERS: WHY SHOULD YOU LEARN CPR? WHY LEARN TO USE AN AED?



JUNE 1 - JUNE 7 is NATIONAL CPR AND AED WEEK

Linda is trained in Advanced First Aid, and was a member and coordinator of a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). Linda was a Red Cross Disaster worker for four years and has assisted in First Aid-AED and CPR training for the last three years. Linda maintains the AEDs and all First Aid kits in Palm Hill.

AEDS IN PUBLIC PLACES

Your chance of survival while waiting for emergency medical services during a cardiac emergency decrease by 10% every minute without Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). Of the people with cardiac arrest who receive a shock from an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) in the first minute, nine out of 10 live. Bystanders administer CPR 40 per cent of the time and AEDs even less so.

Are you one of the 50 percent of people who can locate an AED at your work or out in public buildings? With 10,000 cardiac arrests happening in the workplace annually, you have the potential to save thousands of lives. Immediate CPR and use of an AED can double, or even triple, survival rates.

The American Heart Association does not recommend one device over another. The AED you choose should be simple and easy to use.

When a person collapses, it is most important that someone take charge and instruct another person to call 911 and stay on the line with the dispatcher to convey the exact location and address for the first responders.

Palm Hill has AEDs and First Aid Kits in both the North and South Clubhouses.

Both have the address of the clubhouse on the AED metal case.

The call to 911 should be done at the same time another person is finding the AED and bringing it to the person attending the patient. The person with the patient should be assessing whether to start CPR. (<https://www.redcross.org/take-a-class/cpr/performing-cpr/cpr-steps>).

WHERE ARE PALM HILL'S AEDs?

Clubhouses:

South: AED and First Aid Kit are on the far wall to the right of the kitchen.

North: on the back wall between the Men's and Ladies bathrooms.

Inside the AED box are pads and a diagram that shows where to place the pads on bare skin. Once the device is turned on, a recorded voice tells the person using the AED exactly what to do. Some devices offer this instruction in Spanish, but most are English-speaking.

- The first thing the AED will do is determine whether an electric shock is needed by analyzing the person's heart rhythm. You should only stop cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) while the machine is doing this analysis. If no shock is advised, it will tell you to resume CPR. If there is a shockable rhythm, it will tell you to press the Shock button and then to resume CPR.

Children and AEDs

Children older than 8 years can be treated with a standard AED. For children 1 to 8 years old, the American Heart Association recommends the pediatric-attenuated pads that are purchased separately. In infants younger than 1 year, a manual defibrillator is preferred. If a manual defibrillator is not available, an AED with a dose attenuator may be used.

FLAG DAY JUNE 14

LEARN HOW TO FLY YOUR U.S. FLAG PROPERLY ON FLAG DAY – AND EVERY DAY
Check out the article at www.almanac.com/us-flag-etiquette-rules-and-guidelines.

When the American Revolution broke out in 1775, the colonists weren't fighting united under a single flag. Instead, most regiments participating in the war for independence against the British fought under their own flags. In June of 1775, the Second Continental Congress met in Philadelphia to create the Continental Army—a unified colonial fighting force—with the hopes of a more organized battle against its colonial oppressors. This led to the creation of what was, essentially, the first “American” flag, the Continental Colors.

For some, this flag, which was comprised of 13 red and white alternating stripes and a Union Jack in the corner, was too similar to that of the British. George Washington soon realized that flying a flag that was even remotely close to the British flag was not a great confidence-builder for the revolutionary effort, so he turned his efforts towards creating a new symbol of freedom

On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the Articles of Confederation and passed a resolution stating that “the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white,” and that “the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation.”

EDITOR'S NOTE: In the June LINK, the Palm Hill calendar of the calendar is not reliable since it is out-of-date and omissions and updates or changes about events are possible.

Key Dates In June

On June 14, 1877, the first Flag Day observance was held on the 100th anniversary of the adoption of the Stars and Stripes. As instructed by Congress, the U.S. flag was flown from all public buildings across the country. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary of that decree by officially establishing June 14 as Flag Day.

In the years after the first Flag Day, several states continued to observe the anniversary, and in 1949 Congress officially designated June 14 as Flag Day, a national day of observance for the soon-to-be fledgling nation.

DID YOU KNOW?

- When the flag is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem, it should be destroyed in a dignified and ceremonious fashion, preferably by burning.
- Most American Legion posts will conduct an annual ceremony, often on Flag Day (June 14) to retire old or worn flags; contact your local chapter if you are not able to dispose of the flag yourself. You could also ask your local Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts troops about retiring your flag.

FATHER'S DAY – June 16 – third Sunday of June every year

In 1913, President Woodrow Wilson tried to have Father's Day become a holiday, but it failed to pass through congress. Eight years later, President Calvin Coolidge signed a resolution “to establish more intimate relations between fathers and their children and to impress upon fathers the full measure of their obligations.”

But as times changed and the role of a father, so did the notion of having a holiday.

More than 40 years after Coolidge's resolution, an executive order was signed by then President Lydon Johnson that had Father's Day celebrated on the third Sunday in June. Congress didn't make it a national holiday until 1972.

SUMMER SOLSTICE – First Day of Summer, June 21 at 4:51 P.M.

**4:51 p.m. June 21 marks the magic moment –
the longest day of the year**

In the Northern Hemisphere, the **June solstice** (aka **summer solstice**) occurs when **the Sun travels along its northernmost path in the sky**. This marks the astronomical start of summer in the northern half of the globe. (In the Southern Hemisphere, it's the opposite: the June solstice marks the astronomical start of winter when the Sun is at its lowest point in the sky.)

JUNE RULES AND REGULATIONS REMINDER

Rules and Regulations documents are available in the lobby at the Office.

- **Stickers are required for all vehicles, including golf carts**
- **Cover-ups/shirts**
- **Garbage/Recyclables handling by residents**

ALL VEHICLES are required to be registered with the Office, including all motorized golf carts in Palm Hill.

Forms are on the wall to the right of the glass office window and must be filled out completely to obtain a vehicle sticker, which states **PALM HILL**.

GOLF CARTS: A four-digit sticker from the Office is to be placed on the left side (driver's side) of the golf cart body (not the windshield). It must be visible.

If you have purchased a golf cart in the Palm Hill community that was previously owned and registered, you are required to register said golf cart in your name and address.

ADDITIONALLY: MOTORIZED CARTS USED DURING GOLF PLAY BY GOLFERS must display two additional stickers to be purchased annually at the Office. These are color-coded to each other and the color changes annually on July 1.

One sticker says Palm Hill, to be placed on the left side of the cart body (not the windshield). The other sticker – displaying the term it is valid – to be placed on the right side of the cart body. (Golf carts are only allowed on the Golf Course by golfers during play.)

COVER-UPS

Per Rules XI – E: cover-ups or shirts shall be worn to and from all common areas and facilities.

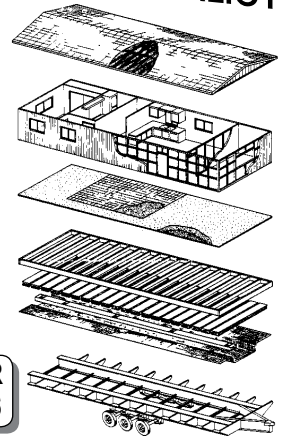

PALM HILL GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES

Reminder, all trash, garbage, refuse must be tied securely.

Recyclables must be placed in a securely tied clear or transparent bag or they will not be picked up. Plastic bags cannot be recycled – please don't put bags inside the clear outer recycling bag.

Cardboard boxes must be broken down.

WHEN TO PUT ITEMS OUTSIDE: Trash, garbage and recyclables must not be placed out the night before collection day as the animals and birds will tear the bags open. Put trash outside on the morning you are designated for pickup.

Trash is picked up:

- Mondays for the North side of the Park
- Tuesdays for the South side of the Park and Palm Forest section

Recyclables are picked up:

- Thursdays in the North side of the Park
- Fridays in the South side of the Park and Palm Forest section

PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 – Q:

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of material handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office shall be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.

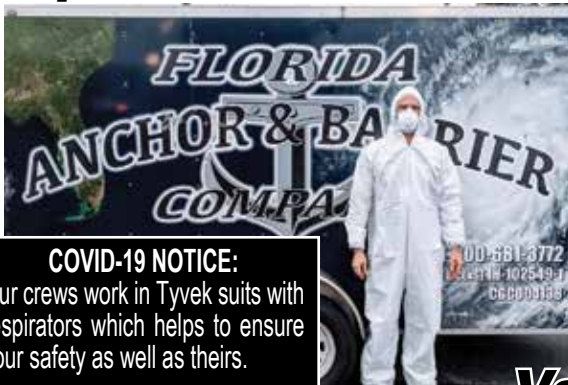

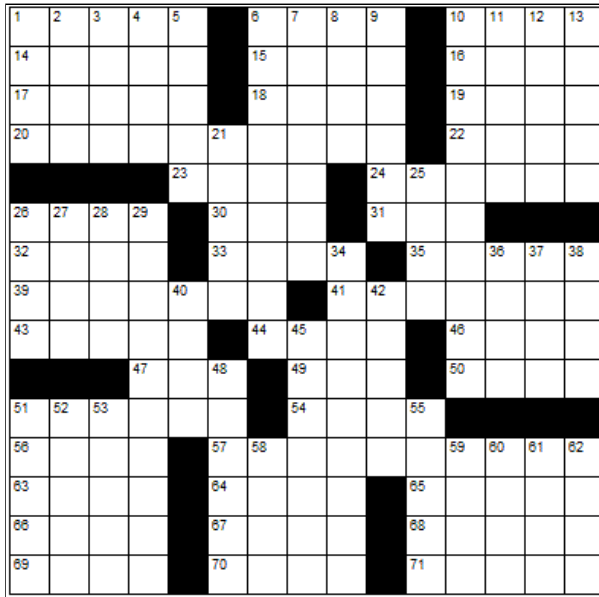

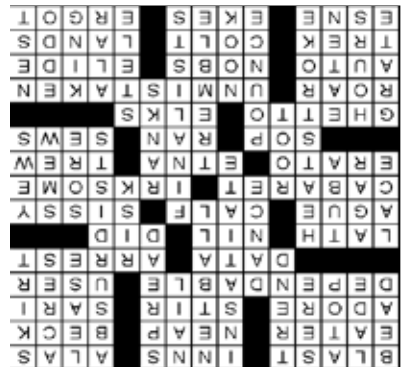
