Telcome to June. I have a requested topic so let's start there and see where it leads.

As you know, the lawn crew is here on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Also for those whose address ends in an even number Tuesday is your watering day. This is causing problems. The lawn crew arrives, and sprinklers are going or have only been off for a short period of

















time and the grass is super wet. Please make sure that you are watering your lawn during the allowed time and make sure it is off between 8 AM and 5 PM Tuesdays so the lawn crew is not dodging sprinklers nor are they getting to your lawn and it is too wet to mow. The lawn crew mentions that it is best to water your lawn, during the drought, after sunset so it doesn't evaporate as quickly from the sun.

I know that when your neighbors are having work done at their home, from deliveries to cleaning of the home, et.al. it can be an inconvenience. Please take the time to be polite. If the workers are blocking your driveway, just ask them to please move so that you can access your carport. If they are having their homes cleaned, the person doing the cleaning may need to step into your yard for a short period of time, so be patient. If a contractor/worker happens to drop material into your yard, such as branches, be patient. They should clean up their mess and it will only be there for a short period of time. Should there be a problem, POLITELY speak to your neighbor and let them know the problem so that they can call the contractor or give you the name and number so you can let the contractor know of the issue.

So, let's enjoy National Ice Tea Month, while making sure that the workers and our neighbors are treated politely and with respect.



MORE EATS

ver allow someone to choose a place to eat and when you see it you automatically think, "Yuk." In this case, after enjoying a couple hours perusing the Impressionism exhibit at the Dali, I thought,



"Oh, great, a burger and fry joint." Was I surprised?!? Ford's Garage at 200 1st, Avenue South in St. Pete may lead you to believe it is similar to a Steak and Shake or The Lube, but it was amazing. Marty and I shared a Fizzy Carburetor (\$10.50) which made me feel I was dining at the Kentucky Derby and having a mint julep, only better and far less costly. The drink had a hint of citrus and sprigs of mint giving a delightful crisp and refreshing taste as we enjoyed sitting along the walk. While Marty had Shrimp and Grits (\$18.99) I had Chicken Henry (\$11.99) and a side salad. His grits were the smoothest ever! The shrimp were a mouthful and plentiful. My chicken had a topping that included feta cheese which had melted and blended into the sauce making it so smooth and rich in flavor. It was served with mashed potatoes sprinkled with fresh parsley. The side salad seemed large and the lime dressing made another fantastic refreshing dish. I savored each and every bite. We brought the Bourbon Pecan Pie with cream (\$10.50) home and had it after the fullness of our meal had settled. This meal reminded me of traveling along the coast of Maine and stopping at a shack for seafood, wondering if the food would be "decent," only to find the best lobster you ever had.

On a lesser note, a group of us tried the Metro Diner in St Pete at 5250 4th Street N. the next day and were disappointed. Two of us had breakfast, the sausage gravy with biscuits (\$11.79) was considered average and not something to be ordered again and while I had cinnamon pancakes with pecan topping (\$9.99) I think the pancakes I make are better and I would not order them there again. One person had steak tips & scrambled eggs in a small dish (\$13.99) and claimed they were not steak tips and the other had a bowl of tangy chicken which was okay (\$10.99). While the prices were pleasing the food was, as Mom would say, "Not worth writing home about."





LFresh ripe tomatoes are in season!



MARY'S TOMATO APPETIZER'S

8 - 10 tomatoes 1 c. mayonaise 1/2 c. sour cream 1 lb. bacon or

3 Tbsp. bacon bits

Cut tomatoes in half and remove insides; drain upside down for one hour on paper towels. Fry bacon until crisp and crumble into small pieces (or you can use bacon bits). Combine mayonnaise, sour cream and bacon. Stuff drained tomatoes with mayonnaise mixture. Sprinkle more bacon on top. Refrigerate till needed.

Note: I use Compari tomatoes.

STUFFED TOMATO SALAD

1 can tuna fish or chicken breast 1 stalk celery, chopped 2 green onions, chopped You can add ripe olives, chopped green pepper or other fresh vegetables as you like. Moisten the mixture with salad dressing or mayonaise. Chill.

Cut a whole ripe tomato into 8 wedges, without cutting through to the bottom of the tomato. Spread the tomato wedges into petal shapes. Place the tomato on lettuce leaves and fill with salad mixture.

COFFEE COFFEE CAKE

(It's made with coffee grounds and is so good!)

Grease 9 x 9 baking pan

Mix together - 1/4 c. dark brown sugar, 1/4 c. sugar, 1 tsp baking soda,

1/2 tsp baking powder, 2 c. flour, 2 Tbsp. finely ground coffee, 1 Tbsp. cinnamon. Add 5 Tbsp. soft butter, mixing till crumbly.


Whisk together 1 tsp. almond extract, 1/4 c. yogurt, 3/4 c. whole milk, and 1 egg. Add to the dry ingredients, mix just until combined. Pour into baking pan.

Topping: 1/4 c. dark brown sugar, 1/2 c. sugar, 3 Tbsp. flour, 1/2 tsp cinnamon, 3 Tbsp. soft butter. Mix till crumbly - not too fine. Use fingers to drop onto top of cake. Bake at 375 for 30 minutes. When cake is cool, mix 2 Tbsp. fresh brewed coffee with 1/2 c. powdered sugar. Pour glaze on top of cake.


