#### July 2024 / HOA Board Updates

Effective June 3rd your HOA Board has elected Matt Soehnlen as President in lieu of Alan Barron's resignation. To fill the open board position, Cindy Taylor was nominated by the Board for the remainder of Alan's term (ending December 2024). Cindy had expressed a willingness to run for the Board in the December elections and will be a great asset to the Board until that time.

(This special meeting was allowed according to the bylaws).

We thank Alan for his leadership these past 2 years and for all his efforts on behalf of the residents of Gateway. Alan always put the good of the park residents first in his dealings with management.

In reviewing the bylaws, we as a board will be following the guidelines more closely. There will be two (2) immediate changes. First, proxy voting will be allowed for all matters requiring a vote by members. Second, membership which grants voting rights will be payable 30 days prior to a vote. Please see the following for more information on these changes.

- 1) Proxy A proxy form must be completed if you wish to assign your vote for upcoming meetings. A proxy form is only good for the meeting designated on the form and a form must be submitted for each meeting as needed. Proxy forms will be available at meetings and from board members. Only members in good standing are allowed to complete a proxy form. Completed forms must be signed in the presence of the Secretary when submitting.
- 2) Annual Dues In order to be considered a "member in good standing" your annual dues must be paid in full. Currently the dues is \$5.00 per calendar year per household.

Dues must be paid 30 days in advance of any voting, including the Annual Meeting and Elections on December 11, 2024, therefore, dues must be paid by November 11, 2024, to vote in December.

A member in good standing has the right to speak at general meetings, run for open board



positions, and vote on all matters presented to the general membership.

The board will be presenting a few items to be considered by membership at the September meeting, that will then be voted on in October.

If you wish to vote in October, your dues must be paid no later than September 2, 2024. We thank you for your support and look forward to a productive year ahead.

#### **OUR GATEWAY COMMUNITY**

Took a survey ride June 7th. Was nice to see well-trimmed palm trees and as near as I can guess about a dozen and a half newly painted carport driveway. The following info is all unofficial: Fifteen (15) empty lots; Homes with For Sale signs: one (1) SW and one (1) DW on 1 st Lane; three (3) SW on 1 st Way; three (3) SW and three (3) DW on 1 st Street and four (4) SW and two (2) DW on Bay Street. My wife Kathy and I have lived at our home on 1st Street since January of 2006 and when we first arrived neither of us are certain as to just how few golf carts there were. Our recollection is ONE. At the same time our Thursday morning Bike Parades regularly exceeded 70 people at the clubhouse with three to four dozen riders. In addition, each evening (weather permitting), there were a dozen or so of us who together would tour the streets of Gateway chatting among ourselves and waving our greetings to others. There were also others enjoying an evening ride. There were seldom concerns for safety on these occasions, even in the dark, due to the size of the group and the fact that several had lights, front and rear, to alert car drivers to our presence.

There is no question that Gateway is well lit but from my personal experience and that of others I have spoken with there are occasions where dark clothed people and unlit bikes and golf carts appear to be nothing more than shadows in moonlight. As the daytime temperatures begin to climb, people will be inclined to walk and ride after sunset and with the very limited twilight the full darkness comes on quickly. For walkers and bikers who have discovered that the cheap, often defective battery lights are simply junk, you should consider that Home Depot and Amazon safety vests are available for less than \$10.00. Quality bike lights are \$15 - \$20 a set but will continue well beyond the few months of high humidity and the single battery exchange typical for those available at the flea market. There have been additional numbers of motorized chairs, scooters and electric bikes. Those residents using these, at any time to move about on the streets, are encouraged to have bright reflective vests and their chair/scooter should be illuminated or at the very least contain reflectors or bright red, orange or yellow reflective tape to alert auto/ truck/SUV drivers to your presence. And because Gateway does not have sidewalks, or speed bumps, your motorized chair or personal travel scooter should be operated as a motor vehicle on the right side of the streets. Remember that single golf cart in 2006? I counted 32 scattered around and throughout our Gateway community. They can be observed at all hours of day and night traveling about the streets on various errands, chores, visits or simply to take a ride. My main concern is that their presence on the street is not always apparent and the fact that they are electric silent speedy and not always well lit, can present a hazard, especially to those on foot or biking when approached from behind. Golf cart operators are therefore requested to take special care when approaching walkers and bikers from behind and please have lights illuminated when traveling about the park after dark. Dog owners should also consider placing reflective tape on their animal collar. Should they escape your home, especially at night, it could save their life from the wheels of a vehicle and would also make it easier to identify and recover. At the same time, exercise and dog walkers should wear light colored clothing after dark and consider purchasing and wearing reflective safety vests. Remember to walk on the side of the street facing oncoming traffic, so that golf carts, quiet cars or even a bike approaching you from behind stand a chance to avoid you or stop as you or your pet suddenly move further into the

- Stop. Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and call another family member to check out the story.
- Pass this information on to a friend. You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.

#### **FREE GROCERIES**

ood Neighbors is the charity that provides free grocery products every First Wednesday of Each Month. Doors open at 11:30 am to begin lining up. Distribution begins once our volunteers have prepared the tables with the groceries. Each month is different depending on what they bring us. There is always planty of fresh produce, fruit most and baked goods. We also usually

is always plenty of fresh produce, fruit, meat, and baked goods. We also usually receive eggs, some dairy products, and lots of miscellaneous items. There are a few rules for the distribution: 1) bring a large bag, 2) one shopper per household, 3) be king and considerate of those in line behind you - only take what you can use and follow the instructions of the volunteers, and 4) only 1 (one) meat item per household until everyone has completed through the line. Once everyone has been served you may go through the line a second time. These groceries come from Winn-Dixie, Publix, Whole Foods, and Trader Joes. Yes, some items may be expired, but they cannot be distributed unless they meet FDA guidelines.

#### **HISTORY OF PASS – A – GRILLE**

or 10,000 years, Indians hunted the prairies and fished the water of what later became Pass – A – Grille. The last group of Native Americans to settle in the Pinellas County area were the Totoabas around 1,000 = 1,700 AD. This area was first visited by Europeans in 1528 when the Spanish Explorer, Panfilo de Narvaez anchored off Pass-A-Grille pass. Afterwards, the island was used as a campground for fisherman to obtain fresh water and the grill their catch. According to legend, it is thought that Pass – A Grille derives its name from the French Passe aux Grillers. In 1857 John Gomez, self-styled 'last of the pirates', began bringing excursionists here from Tampa which gave the area the distinction of perhaps being the oldest resort on Central Florida's West Coast. Zephaniah Phillips, the first homesteader, settled there in 1886 and by the turn of the century Pass - A - Grille has it's first hotel and ferry boat service from what is now Gulfport.




