

- There are 3 dumpsters that everyone is allowed to use. You are not assigned to one dumpster, so if your usual dumpster is full, please take to one of the other two.
- Do not put trash in the blue recycle bins, also no garbage bags or grocery bags in the recycle bins.
- When it comes to recycling, we put out a pamphlet in the newsletter to remind everyone of all the do's and don'ts of recycling in Clearwater (It is different in every county and every state). Please follow the flyer and when you are in doubt, please just throw it out. It is better to throw it out than to put the wrong items into the recycling system. If you need a new one just ask the office, we will be glad to give you one.

If you have any scrap metal or old appliances that you need to get rid of, there is a junkman that will come to your home and pick it up and take it off for free for you. Ronnie Kitchen at 727-657-4428, He will also come and pick up those items that you are not allowed to put in the dumpster, such as mattresses, furniture, or other large items but he does charge a FEE for this. You can also call a local thrift store such as St Vincent's, hospice, goodwill, or Salvation army and donate to them if the item is in good repair.

Recipe of the Month

Broccoli Salad

Ingredients:

- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- ½ cup mayonnaise I recommend using Duke's
- 3 ½ cups broccoli florets or one medium head of broccoli chopped
- ½ cup grated sharp cheddar I recommend grating it yourself, if possible.
- ¼ cup grated mozzarella
- ½ cup bacon bits
- salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. In a bowl combine the sugar and apple cider vinegar.
- 2. Stir in the mayonnaise and whisk together. Whisk until smooth.
- 3. Add the broccoli then stir well.
- 4. Add cheese and bacon bits. Refrigerate for a few minutes before serving.

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
 use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
 understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.
