



CAN TABS FOR DONATIONS


They have a bucket in their driveway - just drop them in anytime.

CARES NETWORK (HOA) Debbie Mills – Co-Chair | 309-696-1444

The HOA Cares Network is a group of residents who are creating a way to connect with neighbors who need daily contact to make sure they are safe and healthy. Some Neighbors L asked to be contacted because they are recovering from surgery or illness. Others are concerned about falling and being unable to call for help. The Cares Network process is fairly simple.

- 1. A resident, friend, or family member contacts the Cares Network to suggest a Neighbor in need of a daily phone call or text message.
- 2. Someone from the Cares Network talks with the Neighbor in need to make sure they want to receive calls or messages. If they are willing, they are matched with a Volunteer.
- 3. The Volunteer and Neighbor talk to make a plan for how often the calls or messages happen and the networking begins.

Volunteers who will be unavailable due to travel or other events ask another Volunteer to contact their matched Neighbors during their absence. The Cares Volunteers do not provide medical advice, transportation, or personal services.

There are 15 members of the Cares Network committee, co-chaired by David Casady (HOA Board member) and Debbie Mills at Lot #646.

If you or someone you know lives alone, is socially isolated, has limited mobility or may need daily contact, call or text Debbie Mills 309-696-1444.

In the words of Fred Rogers: "All we're ever asked to do in this life is to treat our neighbor especially our neighbor who is in need—exactly as we would hope to be treated ourselves. That's our ultimate responsibility."

SCAM ALERT Romance Scams www.fbi.gov/h

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- · Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- · Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov

VOLUNTEERS

RV residents volunteer to contact neighbors who sign up for the Cares Network. Each neighbor in need is connected with a volunteer.



TEAMWORK

The volunteer and neighbor agree on the amount (daily, etc.) and type of contact (call, text, etc.). Phone numbers are exchanged.



WHAT IF ...

Volunteers have a list of resources to meet a variety of needs. For example, if contact fails, a wellness check can be requested from Largo PD.



EXCLUSIONS

Volunteers provide daily contact.

They <u>do not</u> provide medical advice, transportation or personal services.






