BOARD OF DIRECTORS

PINELLAS COUNTY WATER RESTRICTIONS

Pinellas counties will be under a Modified Phase I Water Shortage Order limiting lawn watering to once per week through July 1, 2024.

Use of City Water to wash or rinse any driveways, moving vehicle, patio blocks, cars, trucks, boats, trailers, golfcarts, motorcycles, and bicycles is prohibited at any time.



Effective immediately, any Unit owners violating the Pinellas County Phase I code will be reported to Pinellas County and will be subject to the violations listed below.

PINELLAS COUNTY WATER VIOLATIONS

While under the modified **Phase 1** Water Shortage Order, PCU will issue warnings that do not carry a fine for the first offence. A **second** offence will receive a citation that carries a **\$193.00** fine.

If drought conditions worsen and a **Phase 2 order** is issued, any offense will receive a **citation and \$193.00 fine**. For more information after receiving a citation, please contact Business & Customer Services at (727) 464-4000.

GUESTS

Thit owners are required to register overnight guests at the office. Garage/Store building parking requires a permit from the office. Overnight visitors with a vehicle MUST display a permit on the dash.

NEW GUEST BAND POLICY

Each unit will receive two free wrist bands to provide for their guests when they come to visit. When a guest is in Glenwood Estates, they are required to have them in their possession.



These bands are an extension of the Neighborhood Watch Program and designed to make your guests feel welcome and our neighborhood safe. When you don't recognize someone using our amenities, we encourage you to help us enforce this policy by asking that person to display their band.

If that person does not comply with your request, do not engage further, immediately contact the Pinellas County non-emergency number. That number is **727-582-6200**. However, if you see a crime taking place, call

Romance Scams

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- · Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual **seems too perfect** or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- · Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov
