

Saturday, July 20th - NATIONAL MOON DAY on July 20th commemorates the day man first walked on the moon in 1969. NASA reported the moon landing as being "...the single greatest technological achievement of all time."



On July 20, 1969, Apollo 11 (LEM called "Eagle") carried the first humans to the moon. American Neil Armstrong first said "The Eagle has landed" to tell NASA Mission Control that they had made a safe trip to the Moon. Six hours after landing on the moon, he climbed down the ladder and stepped onto the lunar surface. "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind" Armstrong proclaimed. He spent two and a half hours outside the spacecraft.

Buzz Aldrin soon followed, stepping onto the lunar surface. After joining Armstrong, the two men collected 47.5 pounds of lunar material. Their specimens would make the journey back to Earth to be analyzed.


Austin from Westlake Washing says he does a lot of pressure washing in Southwind and he recommends that anytime you schedule any home services to come here, his

SOUTHWIND WILDLIFE SPOTLIGHT

HIS is a Muscovy Duck. Ellie took this photo in her back yard and shared some information about Southwind's history with these ducks. When you see this photo, you may think it's a nice looking bird. He or she looks like it's wearing a tuxedo but the red face looks like a turkey, how unusual. It's very distinctive looking, right?

Muscovy ducks are very social. They are large ducks, weighing an average of 9 pounds (like some dogs around here), with a typical wingspan of 54 - 61 inches! This species are non-migratory and active during the day.

Muscovy ducks are not native to Florida, but are protected under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, but the US Fish and Wildlife Service has issued a Control Order (USFWS 50 CFR 21.54) allowing control of Muscovy ducks and their nests and eggs in areas outside their natural range, including here in Florida.

Muscovy ducks are omnivorous, feeding on roots, stems, leaves, and seeds of aquatic and terrestrial plants, as well as, small fish, reptiles, crustaceans, insects, millipedes, and termites. But they are attracted to bird seed, too. PLEASE DO NOT FEED MUSCOVY DUCKS! They can transmit diseases to or interbreed with Florida's native waterfowl. Their populations can increase quickly, which can lead to excessive "nutrient" loading in small ponds, and messy sidewalks and driveways.

Long time resident Ellie Malloy recalls a major nuisance problem in years past, when these Muscovy ducks took over Southwind. They were not staying near the pond, but were walking the streets and yards, and were pooping all over sidewalks, and carports. We want to avoid unsanitary and toxic droppings that our precious pets can pick up on their paws and bring in the house, or worse - lick their paws and get sick.

There is a lake near here, where the overpopulation of Muscovy ducks is overwhelming. We do not want this problem again here in Southwind, so if you see one of these ducks, please chase them or shoo them away – they run (not fly). They do not "quack", they hiss. Again, they are attracted to birdseed and can become a nuisance very quickly if we invite them to feed here.

Our natural wildlife environment in Southwind is part of our Community's beauty, charm and appeal. Ellie describes it as a bird sanctuary and said that on any given day we can see about eight different varieties of birds, and ducks.



Bluejay's are another bird we see around our community. They like feeding on peanuts in the shell. Here is a photo (by Ellie) of a beautiful bluejay feeding near the pond. Take a walk around the park and enjoy watching our non-human wildlife residents! Nature at its finest...

Killer Key Lime Pie Recipe

from John McGraw

To make Killer Key Lime Pie is as easy as 1, 2, 6 (or if you can't get key limes, 1, 2, 3).

For Regular Key Lime Pie:

1 Can Sweetened Condensed Milk

2 Egg Yolks

1/2 Cup Lime Juice (usually 6 Key Limes or 3 regular Limes)



Blend ingredients together, pour into an 8" graham cracker crust and place in freezer.

To serve: Remove from freezer and let set for 20 minutes at room temperature to get right texture. If you like, garnish with a little whipped cream, a sprig of mint or a thin slice of lime.

For Killer Key Lime Pie:

Double the recipe, make your own graham cracker crust (recipe on the back of box of graham crackers), and use a 9" pie pan (Pyrex is best) that's 1-1.5" deep.

Non purists note: Key Lime Pie is not green. It is a pale creamy color. DO NOT ADD FOOD COLORING! Otherwise, people will think you are a snowbird!

This pie was designed to be eaten on a warm sandy beach while looking at a spectacular sunset! Do not accept imitations.

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- · Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- · Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- · Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.




