ATTENTION RESIDENTS!! NEW HOA WEBSITE!!

s many of you know, the new Shoreline Palms Web Site Phase I is online. You can reach it by going to **SLPHOA.com** (Which is an abbreviation Shoreline Palms SLP and HOA for the Home Owners Association). Currently, you do not have to log in. Available on the site are Officers, Chairpersons, Upcoming Events, Blogs, Informational documents, and many other things. More to come. Please feel free to check it out.

As we move forward, we will (in the next few months) implement various notifications for things like Emergencies, Weather Events, water shut-off and various other items of information that the HOA feels are very important to the Community. This will be done through phone, text, email and web notifications, etc. In order to do this, we need permission to use these methods from the residents of the Shoreline Palms Community.

There will be 2 primary methods to do this:

- 1. Please send the following information in an email to webadmin@slphoa.com
 - a. Name
 - b. Lot#
 - c. Phone Number
 - d. Text number, if different than Phone Number
 - e. Email
 - e. Permission to contact by phone number
 - f. Permission to contact by Text
 - g. Permission to contact by Email
 - h. Permission to contact by Web Notification
 - i. For the four types just put either Yes or No next to the Words Phone, Text. Email, Web.

You are free to approve 1, 2, 3, or all four. The more you approve, the more options that are available to contact you. If you do not want any contact, just don't send anything. The HOA will only contact those that have given their permission through the Notification System.

2. In the next week we hope to have a way to enter this information through the Website. A Menu Item will be added called Notifications and a choice will be included to fill in a form to receive Notifications. Just fill in the form areas like the above options and check the boxes next to the appropriate methods. Your information will be automatically processed and stored to control Notifications.

We look forward to your use of the Website and hope this enhances your living experience in the Shoreline Palms Community.






