Remember manufactured homes are mandatory evacuations no matter what flood zone in which they are located. Looks like they are saying we could have up to fifteen big storms. Pray we do not see that many, affect our area. Always do what will keep you safe! If you were at coffee hour the end of May, Officer Bowling showed us what we need to have in our hurricane kits. Water is a necessity, also spare batteries, flashlights/battery powered candles or lanterns and do not forget your medications. We are trying to obtain more of the Hurricane pamphlets that have been outside the Business Office, we will let you know when another shipment arrives. Over the years we have had to leave the park and stay at a hotel outside of the hurricane landfall area. If you need to shelter in a hotel, make a reservation as early as you can...remember there will many other folks evacuating, and the hotels fill up quickly. Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

#### **Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:**

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
  use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
  understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- · Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
   Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and
- family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.

Yes, the number of attendees is smaller in the summer, but we're still moving along.



s posted on FYI Lincolnshire May 14th, 2024 by our Manager Paul. Starting on 5/15/2024 a scheduled date and time was established for the Maintenance crew to attend to any routine <u>reclaimed well water</u> maintenance/repairs as needed. This scheduled time and day <u>may require shutoff of the well water (non-potable) from 9:00AM to 11:00AM on Wednesdays every week</u>. They may not be required to shut down the well water (non-potable) just serves as notice in advance that well water may be shut off on this day and time.

This pre-scheduled maintenance is not turning off the Fresh Water to your home.

There has been a drop-off of citizens that are registered for mail in ballots because of a measure signed into law more than 3 years ago that requires Florida voters to re-register to receive mail ballots for each election cycle and canceled existing requests after 2022 elections. If you are new to Florida and need to set up your Voter registration or if an existing registered Florida voter that had been voting via mail-in ballot you can check your status with the County Elections office.

If you log into the County Elections website: www.votepinellas.gov/votebymail - you can verify if you are set up to receive a mail in ballot for upcoming elections.

If you do not have internet access you can call: 727-464-8683 to check your mail in ballot status.

You can complete a form to request Vote-by-Mail ballot form. We have placed some copies of the form in the mailroom to assist you. Complete the form completely and mail it to



- o The park drives are graded to direct stormwater runoff to the street drains. Why walkway edges vary in height from the pavement.

### What 'D-Day' Stands For:

wenty years after planning the Allied invasion of Normandy, Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower received a letter that asked him how the June 6, 1944, amphibious assault came to be commonly called D-Day. Answering through his executive



assistant, Eisenhower replied that "any amphibious operation has a 'departed date'; therefore, the shortened term 'D-Day' is used." But retired Army Lt. Col. Mark Calhoun, a senior historian at the National WWII Museum in New Orleans, does not buy Eisenhower's explanation, reasoning that it took more than one day to load the Allies' ships and landing craft for their journey across the English Channel to fight the Germans on the beaches of France. "Some soldiers departed a couple of days earlier than others did, so it has to be the date that you actually arrive," Calhoun told Military.com in a phone interview. "Otherwise, it's going to be different days."

What the "D" in D-Day actually stands for has been a source of debate almost from the time that the Allies first landed on the French coast. It is one of the most frequently asked questions that the tour guides at the National WWII Museum, known as the National D-Day Museum when it opened in 2000, receive from visitors. The magnitude of D-Day -- the 150,000 Allied service personnel who participated, the 4,415 Allied troops killed, the 12 countries that were part of the invasion -- is plain for everyone to see, but pinning down the name's origin has proved elusive for many military historians and observers. Some have asserted that D-Day stands for "Decision Day" or "Designated Day," while others have surmised it is short for "Deliverance Day" or have gone a darker route to "Doomsday" or "Death Day".

Then, there are those who are just fans of repetition, alliteration, or both, believing the "D" stands for Day. And they would be generally correct, according to Calhoun, a former military planner who taught for 14 years at the Army's School of Advanced Military Studies at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. He explained that "D-Day" -- the date a military operation begins -- is a term favored by strategists in plotting out a mission when the precise date is not known. D-Day is part of a common terminology for military planners that also includes H-Hour (the hour a military operation begins -- for D-Day, it was 6:30 a.m. local time -- and M-Day (the date that mobilization for an operation begins). Such jargon proved especially useful in the planning to invade Normandy, which Calhoun said actually began in early 1942, more than two years before Germans spotted the first Allied paratroopers on the French coast. Relying on all-encompassing terms instead of actual dates also can avoid confusion when the plan changes, such as when D-Day was originally scheduled for June 5, 1944, but pushed back a day because of a forecast for bad weather. Adding or subtracting days from an operation's start is much easier, too, under this planning method, according to Calhoun. For example, military planners use "D-2" to mean "two days before D-Day" and "D+6" to indicate "six days after D-Day," avoiding exact dates

and maintaining operational security. "So, you can't say, 'It's June 1, so this has to happen on May 1,' but you can say 'D-Day' and then you can say 'D-30,' and now you can do all of your planning and you can have this long, detailed timeline where you've got a D-Day and you've got things ... that are going to have a D plus and a D minus," Calhoun explained.

"Once you finally pick your D-Day, then all you have to do is insert '6 June' where D-Day is, and then your minuses and your pluses, you can do the math and you know all the dates." The first time that the U.S. Army is believed to have referenced a "D-Day" was on Sept. 7, 1918, about two months before World War I ended. Field Order No. 9, First Army, American Expeditionary Forces, stated: "The First Army will attack at H hour on D Day with the object of forcing the evacuation of the St. Mihiel Salient [in France]." Calhoun, though, said such military terminology goes back further than that, to the mid-19th century and the Prussian general staff under Helmuth yon Moltke the Elder.

World War II included other "D-Days" besides the one at Normandy, including in North Africa and Sicily, but in the public consciousness, only one invasion comes to mind. The impact of what that day represents in U.S. military, American and world history cannot be overstated, and as D-Day's anniversary approaches, those four letters still stir a sense of reverence for and pride in what the Allies endured that day.

"I have full confidence in your courage, devotion to duty and skill in battle," Eisenhower wrote in his "Order of the Day" on D-Day. "We will accept nothing less than full Victory! Good Luck and let us all beseech the blessings of Almighty God upon this great and noble undertaking." In that message to the troops, Eisenhower never referenced "D-Day." Somehow, it did not seem necessary.

his Voice issue is the final part of choosing or changing your Medicare Part C (Medicare Advantage Plans).

- ❖ What are the <u>disadvantages</u> to a Medicare Advantage plan?
- Medicare Advantage can become expensive if you are sick, due to uncovered copays especially if hospitalized. No guarantee that all the providers and vendors like your DME (oxygen and concentrators as examples) are included in the plan when that happens. Leading to changes. Always ask! All benefits are available in both print (Medicare mandate) and online through the plan's website. \*Remember to select the plan you want or selected. At least the sections on ER, outpatient tests like CT's/MRI's and hospitalizations.
- Additionally, a plan may offer only a limited network of doctors, which can interfere with a patient's choice. \*\*Make sure your favorite Primary Physician is still eligible to be your Primary! Specialists too if you see them often. Also call them to ensure they are still participating.
- And it is not easy to change to another plan. If you decide to switch back to a Medigap policy, there often are lifetime penalties. Windows in time where changes are possible are limited each year. Why necessary homework pays off.
  - ❖ Types of Medicare Advantage Plans. Know what you are getting!
  - ✓ Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) members usually receive services through the plan's local network of providers. Referrals to see a specialist and other providers are required. However, plans allow out-of-network care for emergencies and out-of-area dialysis. Prescription drug coverage is included in HMO plans, and many plans include some coverage for dental, vison, and hearing. Again, our favorite Dentist may not participate in that plan.
- ✓ Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) members can usually use in-network Doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other healthcare providers that agree to health plan members' services and supplies at a set price are in-network providers. However, visits to non-network providers could cost significantly more. PPO plans often include prescription drug coverage and other benefits, and referrals are typically not required for specialist visits.
- ✓ Medicare Medical Savings Account (MSA) plans are private companies that the Medicare program pays to manage a beneficiary's Medicare benefits. As with all types of Medicare


