This month's second topic is ... Approval for patios, etc.

Teakwood management (Rules and Regulations Section H).

When you submit plans to Teakwood for any exterior additions, alterations or renovations, Teakwood's approval is only saying that you may do the approved work on Teakwood land. You <u>must</u> contact the City of Largo to verify if you need a permit for the work. Teakwood Village does not know what the requirements the city has, so it is your responsibility to obtain any permits required and pay the penalty if you do not obtain the permit prior to the work being done. Please refer to your copy of the Rules and Regulations, Section I, for the complete rules and regulations pertaining to additions.



HOW TO AVOID HEAT STROKE

uring our hot Florida summer heat stroke and heat exhaustion can be a very erious matter especially for seniors. Heat stroke occurs when your body has had too much exposure to high temperatures, causing its cooling system to fail. At this point, your body temperature may rise to dangerously high levels.

There are some telltale signs of heat stroke:

- Excessive sweating
- Skin is hot to the touch
- · Difficulty thinking and reasoning
- Fatigue, rapid heart rate and loss of appetite may occur

In severe cases of heat stroke, your brain and other vital organs may shut down, which could lead to death.

Dr. Mayer says staying hydrated is key to combatting heat illnesses. "Have your hydration and fluids readily available and be sure to hydrate continually throughout the day." Drinking water and sports drinks is best, especially during vigorous exercise. Drinks with caffeine or alcohol can lead to dehydration.

Here are other precautions to consider in order to avoid heat stroke:

- On hot days, opt for light-colored, lightweight and loose-fitting clothing.
- Take rest periods in the shade or in cool areas.
- Certain health conditions and medications can make you more susceptible to heat illnesses. Talk with your healthcare provider for advice to stay safe.

Emergency medical care is necessary whenever these precautions don't succeed in preventing

heat stroke. Heat stroke requires immediate medical care. If you suspect heat stroke, call 911. **Heat exhaustion:**

- Symptoms: Heavy sweating, weakness or tiredness, cool/pale/clammy skin; fast or weak pulse, muscle cramps, dizziness, nausea or vomiting, headache, fainting,
- First Aid: Move person to a cooler environment, preferably a well air- conditioned room. Loosen clothing.

Please ask those you believe to be in need if they would like assistance in preparing for bad weather by securing their awnings, putting items that could damage homes away in sheds and homes, etc. prior to beginning. Do not assume they want or need your help.

Out of genuine concern for the welfare of all our residents, I do ask that if we are asked to evacuate, you comply with that request. Additionally, because of the forecasted activity, if your home is one that others have secured for the weather to come, please know that you cannot realistically expect them to return everything to its original state, only to go through it again with the arrival of the next possible storm. So, to be entirely straightforward and transparent, once your home has been secured, it's secured for the entire season.



This version includes potato salad covered with salad vegetables. The potato salad can be omitted if you like.

6 potatoes

1/4 c. parsley, chopped

2 celery stalks, chopped

1/4 c. mayonnaise

1 large head lettuce

1 cucumber, peeled and cut into 8 fingers

1/4 lb. Feta cheese

8 slices canned beets

12 black olives

4 radishes, fancy cut

1/2 c. white vinegar

Oregano

2 medium onions or 4 green onions, chopped

1/2 c. green pepper, chopped

2 Tbsp. oregano

1/4 c. sour cream

2 tomatoes, cut into 6 wedges each

1 avocado, peeled and cut into wedges

1 green pepper, cut into 8 rings

12 peeled, cooked shrimp

8 Solonika peppers

4 whole green onions

1/2 c. olive oil

Potato salad: Boil potatoes till tender. Drain and chop into a bowl. Add onion, pepper, celery, oregano and parsley. Fold in mayonnaise and sour cream, using more if necessary.

Salad: Line a large platter with outside lettuce leaves and spoon potato salad in center. Shred remaining lettuce and place over potato salad. Layer the following over the lettuce: tomato, cucumber, green pepper slices, green onions, Salonika peppers. Add avocado slices around the outside edge of platter. Next, place beets, black olives and shrimp on top. and sprinkle with feta cheese and dried oregano. Mix the vinegar and olive oil and drizzle over salad.





STRAWBERRY JELLO ICE CREAM PIE



very light dessert popular in the 60's, so easy to make, with fresh strawberries.



Stir 1 small package strawberry Jello - (not sugar-free) into 1-1/4 c. boiling water, mixing until dissolved. Add 1-pint vanilla ice cream, mixing until dissolved. Chill until almost set; then add 2 c. sliced strawberries (keep a few whole strawberries for decoration). Pour into baked one-crust pie shell - chill until completely set. Serve with whipped cream.


