

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- · Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
 Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and
- family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.

JULY FUN FACTS

Tuly is, on average, the warmest month in most of the Northern hemisphere.

The month was renamed in 44BC after Julius Caesar whose birthday fell in the month. Before Caesar, July was called Quintilis,



meaning the fifth month. This was because the months of the year used to be in a completely different order. When the Gregorian calendar was introduced in 1582, January and February were placed at the beginning of the year moving July to the 7th month. The AngloSaxons had multiple names for the month of July, including Maedmonath and Heymonath. Respectively, these translated into "the flowering of meadows" and "hay month."

July is known for the highest number of US presidents' death, as opposed to the month of May, where no US Presidents have died. In all, seven US presidents have died so far in July, which is way higher than any other month.

On July 4, 1776, the 13 American colonies declared their independence from the British monarchy. The 4th of July, formally known as Independence Day, has been a federal holiday since 1870 in the United States of America.

July is the 7th month of the year and has 31 days. It is is the warmest month in the Northern Hemisphere on average.

No month ends on the same day of the week as July unless it is a leap year, when January does so.

July's birthstone is the ruby.

On the 20th of July, 1969, after 240,000 miles and 76 hours in the air, the first ever manned spacecraft represented by astronauts Neil Armstrong and pilot Buzz Aldrin, landed on the moon. Armstrong and Aldrin, fully equipped in their thick space suits, exited the spacecraft slowly and made history as the first people to walk on the surface of the moon.

If you're doing everything right, then crops of corn are meant to be "kneehigh by the fourth of July." It's also in July that crop circles start to appear in fields of corn. For the most part, Crop circles have only started appearing since the 1970s, although there have been a number of cases sporadically reported throughout history.

July has two birth flowers – the water lily and the larkspur. The water lily is a symbol of a pure heart,

In early July, a period of time called the "dog days of summer" begins. Historically they were observed within Ancient Roman and Greek astrology and were connected with bad luck, mad dog attacks, unexpected thunderstorms, heat, and drought. They gained their name as "dog days" as they were connected with the star Sirius, which is part of the Canis Major (Greater Dog) star system. Nowadays, "the dog days" refers to when the hottest days of summer begin.

Coincidentally, it was in July that the rabies vaccine was first successfully given to a patient. The French microbiologist Louis Pasteur administered the vaccine to a nine year old called Joseph Meister on July 6, 1885. The child had been bitten by a rabid dog, and Louis Pasteur, unsure whether the vaccine would be successful, decided it was worth testing. Fortunately for the boy, it worked!

On July 5, 1946, the world's first bikini was unveiled in the famous Piscine Molitor swimming pool in Paris. Just in time for the heat of summer, the bikini was modeled by showgirl Micheline Bernardini. While two-piece forms of swimwear previously existed, none



RUMORS

Rumors get started so very easily in a community of our size. I would ask that if you haven't researched the statement you are about to make on Social Media that you please do your due diligence and find out it is indeed factual. I am not talking politics,



social issues ethical issues, or religion. I am talking about what Cal-Am can and cannot do, what is expected of the residents by the Prospectus, Rules and Regulations and Statute 723. All of which are readily available to residents. You can get a copy of the Prospectus and the Rules and Regulations from the office. The current Florida stated approved copy of the Prospectus is dated 04-21-2022, this includes the Rules and Regulations. This Prospectus and the Rules and Regulations cannot changed until the next negotiations.

Example of a recent statement (this was not a rumor, but one I feel need to be addressed for the resident's sake), if you are told we have to wash our homes twice annually, they are incorrect. The prospectus says "The exterior surfaces of the manufactured home including the eaves and trim shall be kept free of mildew or discoloration. Manufactured homes must be washed at least annually." This means if you have any mildew on your home, you only have to wash that area as it arises. You only have to have the entire home washed annually.

Another one going around is that Cal-Am cannot walk around to do a four-sided inspection. The lease agreement in the Prospectus Item 10 "Right of access. Tenant grants Landlord the right of access to the premises for all reasonable and necessary purposes, including but not limited to repair and replacement of utilities and protection of the Park, said access to be made at a reasonable time except in exigent circumstances." As much as I wished they did Cal-Am does not have to provide written notice of an impending lot inspection.

What does the HOA do for you?

This is a favorite question of mine. Since it appears on the surface the HOA only hosts parties and raises funds for negotiations, which is



L parties and raises funds for negotiations, which is a significant part of what goes on. I can't list everything nor would you want me to do that here.

First, I would like to discuss negotiations and how the ability of the HOA to be able to afford a mediator if required (most of the times they are). If the HOA does not raise enough funds for said mediation, then we must ask for donations prior to be able to hire the mediator. This is not cheap by any means.

Secondly, the HOA has a Liaison committee to work with Cal-Am on issues affecting homeowners. There are certain steps that must be taken before the Liaison committee can even get involved. 1. Homeowner must file a resident concern form with Cal-Am and provide the HOA with a copy. 2. If the resident is not satisfied with Cal-Ams response and the issue violates the Prospectus, Rules & Regs and most importantly Statute 723, the Liaison Committee will be able to intercede, but we cannot guarantee the homeowner and the HOA will prevail at this time. 3. Then, if needed we can call our attorney to engage in the matter.

Everyone needs to keep in mind, as a resident we are responsible for reporting our own concerns. The HOA cannot report them for you, that is second hand, unless of course they were also there. Then both the homeowner and the HOA board member need to turn in a concern form.

If concern forms are not submitted to Cal-Am Property Manager many times nothing can be done about the situation. Please be as specific as possible in the concern forms, dates, times and pictures, etc. These all help to get the situation resolved. I will warn you though Cal-Am will not get involved in neighbor disputes, that is between the two neighbors and no one else. If there is a physical altercation and you witness it or the police are called, please turn in the concern form, it may seem to you like Cal-Am already knows and they probably do, but if it is just a Cal-Am employee reporting it their lawyer will ask for the concern forms from the residents. Lets help each other to make this a happy, safe place to live.

In all of that I only answered a little bit of what your HOA does and doesn't do for you. I am going to put together a couple of meetings later this summer and then again in the fall so our northern residents will be able to attend also. These meeting will address what we do, what Statute 723 says the HOA can do and what it allows Cal-Am to do, the Prospectus and Rules and regulations. These are <u>not</u> HOA sponsored meetings, they are simply me as a resident wanting to educate as many people as possible in what our rights are in this community.
