From the Board of Directors

ugust is usually a quiet month in Blue Jay and hopefully that trend will continue. There are no holidays, just plenty of heat. We have had a bit of rain, and the lakes are higher



than they have been in a while, but we have not recovered from the 2 years of drought yet. The County recently extended our water restrictions through September 1, so don't rush outside and start washing your driveways yet. Hopefully we will continue to get rain and eventually recover fully by the end of the summer. While it is clearly too warm to do very much outside, most of our games are still running in the air conditioned clubhouse. It's never healthy to isolate in your home, so even if you do not want to play, come on over and socialize.

August is also weed month in Blue Jay and this August should prove no different. Remember, although we pay our landscaper to "control" weeds, control cannot be accomplished unless homeowners take the necessary steps to facilitate control. The Florida weed formula is simple:

Water + Heat + Bare Soil = Weeds. Our landscaper "controls" weeds in well-kept beds. This requires homeowners to put down landscape fabric and ground cover as a primary defense. No amount of chemical application and even hand pulling will work if you don't do your part.

For those of you who are up North, just in case you are wondering, the Route 19 project continues, and is getting worse. There are many complaints from business operators and motorists that the elimination of the "turning lanes" to facilitate the construction of the flyovers has greatly impacted on their ability to use the road, especially at rush hour. This project continues to create a huge mess and recent updates indicate that the project completion date has been extended until sometime in 2029, so it is not going away any time soon.

Finally, mark your calendars for the upcoming budget workshops, to be held Thursday August 15th and Thursday September 12th. Both workshops will be held in the clubhouse and begin at 2:00 PM. Our Treasurer is sharpening her pencil in anticipation of our upcoming spending needs, but with inflation continuing strong, there are no promises or predictions being made for 2025 spending or fees. Your input is important. As always, we will do our best, but most of our spending is beyond our control. So please take the time to attend.



The books are looked over and checked to be sure they are not "shop worn", dirty or duplicates and if the material is questionable or undesirable before shelving. We stress that visitors do not put books on the shelf. By doing this our cleaning and inspection process is by-passed and compromised. The librarians are the only to put the books on the shelf.

We ask that you do not drop off unwanted personal books. Check with the Librarians to see if they can be used. Cook books and do it yourself project books are not acceptable.

By following our guidelines, you and everyone can enjoy the library confident that we're doing our best to keep it safe and clean for your reading enjoyment.



Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can
 use details shared on social media and dating sites to better
 understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone.


