HOA President's UPDATES

acebook page: Serendipity Homeowners Association President's Message for AUGUST 2024:

It's HOT! It's ridiculously HUMID! There are daily rumbles of thunder with periodic downpours. Welcome to August in Florida! Month #8, not even halfway through hurricane season. Here in Serendipity Park, we should be in a slow season. Not so! Though not as busy as from November to June, this community is still the best place to be. Take the inspirational Memorial Day celebration, the Memorial Day barbecue (65 attendees!), Strawberry shortcake Tuesdays, Bingo Thursdays, add in the evening activities that continue to take place, then top it all off with the amazing 4th of July barbecue (104 attendees) and what do you have? A great beginning to summer. Not only has our social director and his very capable right-hand gal been busy, so has the HOA.

In April, a few members of the community and three members of the HOA board formed the rent negotiations team. After 2 months of research, meetings, and practice sessions, three of the remaining in-residence team members met with the ELS Regional Manager and our park manager to discuss the 5.75% (our computations resulted in 5.88%) proposed increase in lot rental amounts. Our first and only in person meeting took place on Thursday June 20th. It was a frank discussion of conditions in the park, ELS profits for 2023, inflation, fixed income difficulties and the disaster we face daily dealing with the construction on US 19. The ELS Regional Manager, Doug Jeffries, sat, listened to our presentation, and took copious notes on his iPad. This was a real win since other ELS owned parks had reported that he had walked out of their negotiations. After two weeks of emails back and forth, we not only negotiated a 5.25% for 2024-25 and 5.5% for 2025-2026 increase but we also will continue to receive the \$2500 for each of those years. To my knowledge, not any other park we have been in communication with has received any monies. As part of this negotiating team, I can tell you that I'm glad it's over!

As many of you know by now, the HOA board is now transmitting the monthly Treasurer's detailed report and the monthly meeting agenda electronically to paid members. All other community residents will find one hard copy of both documents on display in the East Clubhouse. Feel free to snap a picture with your phone but DO NOT remove those items from the bulletin board. These documents will be available one week prior to the HOA scheduled meeting. If the monthly meeting is cancelled, the Treasurer's report will still be made available.

On to a less appealing subject. Dogs. We have now had two dog related incidences within the park within a short period of time. One involved a dog attacking another passing dog. The other involved a dog-to-person bite. I don't need to remind our dog owners that their animal needs to be under their control at all times. But did you know that when a dog bites or attacks that doctors/veterinarians are mandated reporters? Did you know that Florida is a full liability state and does not have first bite/attack forgiveness? You need to be aware that these incidences are reported to Animal Control and Pinellas County. Once a dog bites or attacks it is more likely to do it again. Owners are responsible for all medical bills related to such injuries. If your animal



should repeat this behavior, your dog can be euthanized by state mandates. Size and breed are important factors to consider when choosing an animal friend, but don't be mistaken in thinking that small breeds are not as problematic as larger breeds. With the large amount of ESA dogs that reside in our park, incidences such as these have a high probability of occurring. Check the Florida laws. Know your rights and responsibilities.

Let's all have a wonderful summer and enjoy the amenities our park has to offer. Please remember not to work outside in the afternoons, hydrate with lots of water, and most of all enjoy your family, friends, and neighbors!

My responsibility in this position is to take calls from the residents of Serendipity and give weekly feedback to the park manager and the new PCSO Neighborhood Watch Commander, Deputy Jessica Hughey.

Notes from JULY 2024:

No Calls this month! Everyone be aware and stay safe!

Just a reminder if you see something dangerous or feel threatened, call **911**. If it is just to report something suspicious, call the Sheriff's non-emergency number at (727) 582-6200. Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should **ONLY CALL** me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.



"Marilyn's Recipe Corner" by Marilyn Farnworth

From the kitchen of: Buckwheat Queen

PASTA e Ceci (Italian Chickpea and Pasta Stew)

Ingredients:

- 1 cup dry chickpeas
- 1 tablespoon baking soda
- 1 yellow onion
- 1 stalk celery
- 1 small zucchini
- 1 carrot
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 sprig fresh sage leaves
- 1 sprig fresh rosemary
- 1 sprig fresh thyme
- 3 cups chicken broth (or more as needed)
- 2 peeled whole canned tomatoes
- 8 ½ ounces ditalini pasta (Barilla gluten free is good)
- Salt and freshly ground pepper to taste
- 1 fresh cayenne pepper, seeded and minced (add more to taste)
- 1 table extra virgin olive oil

Directions:

- Rinse chickpeas under cool water. Pick up handful of chickpeas and rub them together with your hands under the water to wash the chickpeas. Place chickpeas in a large stew pot, cover with water and add baking soda: swirl chickpeas and water to distribute the baking soda. Leave to soak for 8 hours or overnight.
- The next day, pour chickpeas through a strainer and rinse well under cold running water eliminating any skins or discolored chickpeas; set them aside.
- Grate onion, celery, zucchini, and carrot on the large teeth of a cheese grater. This step is very important as grated veggies have a different flavor than diced.
- Heat 2 tablespoons of olive oil in the stewpot over medium heat and saute grated vegetables for 1 minute. Mix in sage, rosemary, thyme and saute, stirring occasionally until onions are soft and translucent, about 5 minutes.
- Add 3 cups broth, all the chickpeas and tomatoes. Bring to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer until chickpeas are tender, about 1 hour. Stir in pasta. Add more broth only as needed to achieve a thick, stew-like consistency.
- Cook until pasta is tender, with a bite, 8-10 minutes. Taste and season with salt and black pepper. Remove from heat and divide amongst serving bowls. Top each bowl with minced cayenne pepper and a drizzle of extra virgin olive oil.







Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- · Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- · Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- · Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual promises to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov
