PRESIDENT'S CORNER

hey say it is the 'lazy days of summer', but you wouldn't know it based on activities happening all around us here in the park. It sure is hot but it does not feel as though much has slowed down. Committee charters are being worked on, real estate transactions are still happening, and board members continue to step up to conduct new resident interviews even from afar. Our CD investments have increased to \$2.8M and we continue to take advantage of beneficial interest rates. We are blessed. As you are likely aware by now, we are shifting our approach to approval of changes to common areas (for vision work in the park) and will be communicating the process to cast your preference with a vote rather than filling out a consent form. Meanwhile improvements to the clubhouse audio visual equipment are being evaluated for consideration.

The replacement of the clubhouse and maintenance building roof is underway. While it represents some disruption, we are subject to the availability of the vendor. We were required to replace a burnt-out lift pump this past month. *PLEASE, PLEASE DO NOT FLUSH ANYTHING OTHER THAN TOILET PAPER!* This is very costly to the association. The gym renovation is complete with new flooring, baseboards, painted walls, fan, TV, new bathroom vents, and rearrangement of equipment. A new bench and the treadmill are on order. I'd like to extend a special thank you to our RPM staff, in particular: Marilyn Corazza, Brian Wise and Ron Endicott for doing an OUTSTANDING job on this project! Their efforts resulted in significant cost savings and delivered a professional outcome that any association would be proud of. When you see them, please express your appreciation! Kind support is always welcome.

Three new, larger umbrellas were purchased for the pool area to provide additional shade. New signage and additional life rings were purchased for the lake. The board approved the following work that is now being coordinated: removal of the uninhabitable home on 196 Canal, hurricane season palm tree trimming, shuffle court resurfacing, installation of one replacement and one additional security camera at the Gandy Blvd. entrance, and replacement of up-lighting at the lake island with proper subterranean wiring. The office is now working on getting quotes to purchase a commercial icemaker for the kitchen and to replace uneven pavers in the pool area.

I hope you are enjoying your summer wherever you may be. Our thoughts and prayers go out to those who are experiencing health challenges or have recently lost a loved one.

MANAGER'S CORNER

Last month's newsletter article had to do with Hurricane Preparedness MANAGER and having a plan in place for you and your family. In this article I would like to discuss preparing your property for a storm.

Let's Talk Carports - Are you complying with park Rules & Regulations with regard to your carport?

VII. HOMESITES #6, #14 and #18

- 6. All homes, carports, or any other items placed on a home site by a Resident must be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Management reserves the right to require repairs, repainting or other maintenance that is needed to comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations of state, county, city or Park, as amended from time to time.
- 14. Each Resident is required to keep their lot and driveway free of debris. Patios/carports may not be used for storage and only furniture designed for outdoor use is allowed outside the home. No shopping carts may be left or stored overnight in the carport or yard.
- 18. Storage: To avoid fire hazards and to promote safety, the space immediately under the home shall not be used for storage. Patios/carports may not be used for storage and storage on home sites is prohibited, unless written approval is received from Management.

While rules are in place for your safety and to keep harmony within the community, the importance of the rules that are listed above become even more evident during hurricane season when strong winds and rain can damage or upend loose items and turn them into projectiles.

Remember that a category one hurricane has winds of 74 - 95 miles per hour, so look around your carport and the exterior of your home and remove loose items that can be knocked over or blown away during a storm (this includes hanging plants), and place them in your shed, bring them inside, or dispose of them.





THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

I urting people, hurt people! Maybe you've heard this. I know that this is not intentional if true at all. But the reality is that all of us have had hurt at some time in our life. What have you done when you hurt? What have I done when I've hurt. Often, we have no idea what to do. Other times we pursue some way of alleviating the pain. At times we just sit in our pain. We isolate! We think - no one has been through this like me. In community, if we dare to share our hurt, we discover someone who has hurt like us. It happened to us when we moved to Sunset Palms almost four years ago.

It was four months since our only child, our son died, having battled mental health for 26 years. He was an honor student and athlete. But he broke his leg in a basketball championship game and life changed. Physicians gave a tragic diagnosis. Matthew cared for people. Even when hospitalized doctors would tell us how much they appreciated how Matthew encouraged others. They told us he was an asset. I'm getting to my point.

The point is that we met two very special people, Joe and Connie Pepin who shared a similar pain. (And our son's friend found us the home where we live now, just across the street from where the Pepins lived.) One of their children had died. That day we became special heart to heart friends. That day we prayed together. They cried with us. Connie hugged us. So did Joe. Our relationship grew. Connie and Joe became close friends, not because of extended time of building friendship but because of the deep pain we felt in the loss of a child.

Little would we have known to go to them for comfort. Just knowing that they knew how we hurt, encouraged us, helped us in ways to press on. They were another Mom and Dad who had walked where we were walking. We were being insulated by caring people. I don't know what your hurt might be. But one thing I know, there are people who hurt like you.

I want to encourage you to dare to "insulate and not isolate." Share the hurt. The pain often is cut in half when it is received by someone who sincerely cares. And I would encourage a next step... to pray to God.

May I pray with you?

Prayer: The Bible tells us that God is near the broken hearted. I ask for that nearness, God, when it doesn't even seem possible. Knowing the reality of hurt often leads us to anger and distancing ourselves from You. I lean into You, God, and pray for any friend who is hurting today. I know You hear my heart and I know You know who is hurting. Please bring the peace in the midst of the storm for the one who hurts. In Jesus' name I pray.






