Managers Moment

Tater leaks...if you have a water leak inside, outside, or under your mobile, it is your responsibility to get it fixed. People tend MANAGER to rationalize that a leaking hose connection is a minor issue, but multiply that by 400, and it is a substantial amount of water. The water bills are one of the many considerations used in the annual rent increase. Did you know that, in addition to the water fee, the sewer fees from the county are based on the water usage? The park has three (3) zones/ meters; maintenance reads the meters several times a week and know what average usage is. If these numbers are high, you will notice them walking through all the yards, trying to f ind leaks. We recently had this problem. A toilet that runs continuously is also a problem.... replacing your toilet is a relatively small expense, or maybe it is just the inner workings of the tank that needs to be replaced. aware of the water shortage Maintenance will be coming around if you had a blue flag and help to see if you have any leaks.! We still have a few dumb.....es who refuse to put their garbage where it belongs. Some have gotten belligerent with residents when they bring it to their attention. I have been asked several times why I don't just fine the offenders; you know, hit them in the pocket where it counts. HOWEVER, I was advised by the State of Florida attorneys that this is not allowed. As most of you know by now, we are governed by Florida Statute 723, which is a great thing, except when it's not! BUT, management can write up a violation and if you get three for the same thing, you may find yourself evicted. Pool showers....these are "rinse-off" showers ONLY! No soap, shampoo, etc. is allowed. Rinse off before you get in the pool and rinse off when you get out if you want to remove the chlorine from your body, but DO NOT use it as a hygienic shower. Regarding the pool, I need to remind you that NO GLASS is allowed inside the pool fence area. Also, you may have noticed we have some new chairs and umbrellas. Please make sure you put the umbrella down if you open it, If you leave and see someone forgot, let's do a good neighbor thing and make sure they are all down if you are the last to leave. This is one of those things where a few bad apples will end up spoiling it for everyone If it's windy, don't put up also.

One last thing: Parking on the street all day is getting to be a problem. Please do not block



someone's driveway, it's the right thing to do. Also make sure you leave space for a car or emergency vehicle can get through; some streets occasionally have ben impossible to drive through.



To aid in the transition to a British Crown dependency, the following rules are introduced with immediate effect:



Hurricane Follow Up

URRICANE SEASON Yes, folks, it's that time again. Hurricane Season runs June 1st through November 30th and the time to start preparing is NOW. This year I thought I'd consolidate the information into a checklist of sorts. So, here goes:

- 1. Power. What are you going to do if the power goes out? If you purchased a generator, be sure to store your gas responsibly. If you plan to rely on flashlights and lanterns, check your batteries. It is a good idea to have at least one full set of replacement batteries for 'just in case'
- 2. Cash. Set aside some cash for necessary expenses. If the power goes out the ATMs at the bank cannot dispense money.
- 3. Bottled water. Buy an extra case of water now and store it in the closet until the end of the season. It won't spoil. NOTE: You should also have 1 gallon of water per person for personal hygiene.
- 4. Paper products. Get a pack of paper plates, some paper bowls and plastic silverware. If the power goes out or the water supply is disrupted, you will not be able to wash dishes. Also grab a handheld can opener. That electric one won't work if electricity goes out!
- 5. Important papers. Gather your important documents and secure them in a watertight container.
- 6. Medications. Make sure you always have a 30-day supply of medications on hand
- 7. Pack a "go bag" for you (and another for your fur baby, if you have one). Important things to pack? As a minimum, you should include several changes of clothing, medications, chargers for all your electronic devices, and hand sanitizer. Important items for your fur baby include leash and collar, pet carrier, immunization records, and food (don't forget food and water dishes!).
- 8. As a reminder, manufactured home communities are considered mandatory evacuation zones in the event of a hurricane. You can choose to remain in your home; however, you forfeit access to police, fire, and medical assistance until after the storm passes. Also, NO BUILDING IN THE PARK IS A DEDICATED HURRICANE SHELTER.





Scammers are good at **pretending to be someone that they're not**. They try to trick you into thinking **a loved one is in trouble.**

Once the scammer makes you think they're your grandson and in trouble, they pressure you to quickly send them money. **But it's all a scam.**Your family member was never in trouble.

- The scammer will say it's **urgent** and that you're the only one who can help.
- The scammer might tell you it's important to keep it secret. They don't want you talking to other family members and friends and realizing it's a scam.
- The scammers will **play with your emotions.** They're counting on you to act quickly to help your family or friend. And they're counting on you to pay without stopping to check out whether there's really an emergency. If you get a call like this, you can be sure this is a scam.

Slow down. Verify.

Example of a Family Emergency Scam Call

Hi Grandpa, it's me.

Sebastian? Is that you?

Yes, it's me, Sebastian.
Grandpa, I'm in trouble, and I need money for bail.

What happened?

Please don't tell
Mom or Dad. I'll get in so much trouble.



Clint Eastwood and Burt Reynolds: In 1959, a Universal Pictures executive dismissed them at the same meeting with the following statements. To Burt Reynolds: "You have no talent." To Clint Eastwood: "You have a chip on your tooth, your Adam's apple sticks out too far, and you talk too slow."

Marilyn Monroe (Norma Jean Baker): In 1944, Emmeline Snively, director of the Blue Book Modeling Agency, told modeling hopeful Norma Jean, "You'd better learn secretarial work or else get married."

Elvis Presley: In 1954, Jimmy Denny, manager of the Grand Ole Opry, fi red Elvis after one performance. He told Presley, "You ain't goin' nowhere son. You ought to go back to driving' a truck."

Alexander Graham Bell: When he invented the telephone in 1876, it did not ring off the hook with calls from potential backers. After making a demonstration call, President Rutherford Hayes said, "That's an amazing invention, but who would ever want to use one of them?"

Thomas Edison: He was one of the greatest inventors in American history. When he fi rst attended school in Port Huron, Mich., his teachers complained that he was "too slow" and hard to handle. As a result, Edison's mother decided to take her son out of school and teach him at home. In his lifetime, Edison produced more than 1,300 inventions.

Franklin D. Roosevelt: Paralyzed by polio at 39, he went on to become one of America's most beloved and influential leaders. He was elected president of the United States four times.

Julia Child: In 1953, she and her two collaborators signed a publishing contract to produce a book tentatively titled French Cooking for the American Kitchen. Julia and her colleagues worked on the book for five years. The publisher rejected the 850 - page manuscript. Child and her partners worked for another year totally revising the manuscript. Again, the publisher rejected it. But Julia Child did not give up. She and her collaborators went back to work again, found a new publisher, and in 1961—eight years after beginning—they published Mastering the Art of French Cooking, which has sold more than 1 million copies.

Douglas MacArthur: He might never have gained power and fame without persistence. When he applied for admission to West Point, he was turned down, not once, but twice. But he tried a third time, was accepted and marched into the history books.

Abraham Lincoln: He entered the Blackhawk War as a captain. By the end of the war, he had been demoted to the rank of private.
