August topic #1: If you change your name, change your telephone number, change your address, change your e-mail address, change your emergency contact, please notify the Main Office, in

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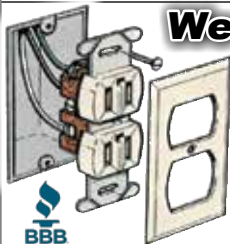

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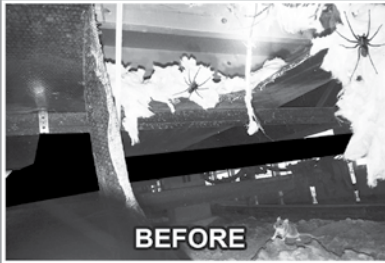
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NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH

ULTIMATE CHICKEN TENDERS

1/2 lb. chicken breast, sliced into 1/2-inch strips

Mix 1/2 c. bisquick and 1/3 c. Parmesan cheese in quart size plastic bag.

Beat 1 egg in bowl. Dip chicken in egg, then into bisquick - cheese mixture.

Place chicken on aluminum foil lined baking sheet. Drizzle with 3 Tbsp. melted butter. Bake at 425 for 12 - 14 min.



COLE SLAW

1 (8 oz).pkg. shredded cole slaw 1/2 c. mayonnaise 2 Tbsp. sugar

1 tsp. white vinegar 1/2 c. crushed pineapple

Mix together all ingredients, adding more mayonnaise if needed. Refrigerate till serving.



CHERRY CRUNCH CAKE

1 pkg. yellow cake mix 1 (20 oz.) can crushed pineapple in syrup, undrained

1 (21 oz.) can cherry pie filling 1 c. chopped pecans

1/2 c. butter, cut in thin slices

Grease 9 x 13 in. pan. Dump undrained pineapple into pan, spread evenly. Dump in pie filling; spread into even layer. Dump dry cake mix evenly over fruit. Sprinkle pecans over cake mix.

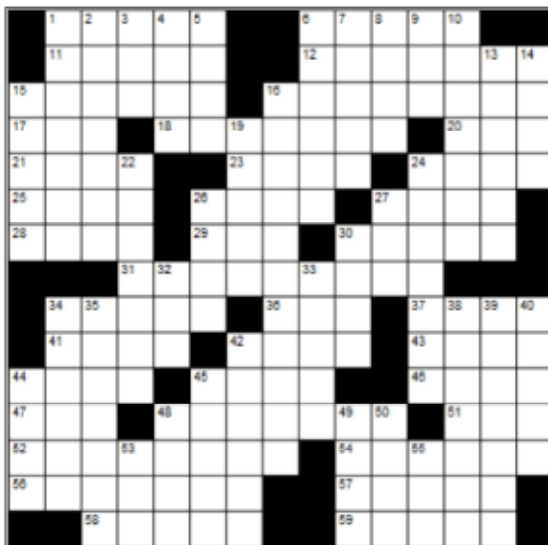
Put butter on top. Bake at 350 for 45 - 55 mi

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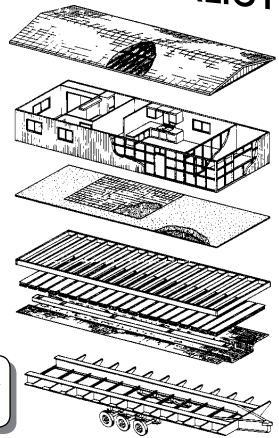

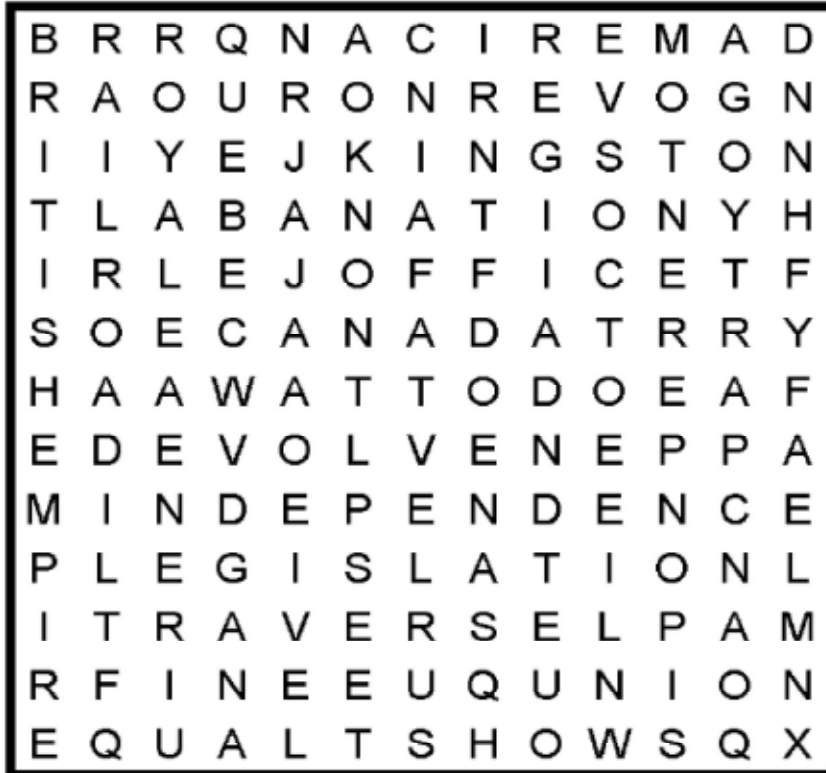
