What to do (and not do) after a car accident

o one ever plans to be in a car accident, but unfortunately many of us will find ourselves involved in one some day. Here's what you should do if you're in an accident, according to the Better Business Bureau:

- 1. Don't leave the scene.
- 2. If there are injuries, call for medical assistance and provide basic first aid.
- 3. Call law enforcement if needed. Once the officer arrives, when appropriate get the officer's name and police station address.
- 4. Ask for the case number, when the accident report will be filed, and how to get a copy.
- 5. Take careful note of the following:
- Date and time of the accident
- Street and city
- Weather and road conditions
- Direction and speed you and other travelers were going
- Description of how the accident occurred
- The numbers of the license plate, driver's license, and insurance policy of each driver involved

You may like blue potatoes, but stay away from the green ones

ost people have seen their potatoes turn strange colors of green, but few likely understand the chemistry of what's going on with the tubers.

The leaves, stems, and sprouts of potatoes contain high levels of compounds called glycoalkaloids (usually solanine and chaconine), which are toxic to humans. These compounds are part of the plant's natural defenses against fungi and insects, and are also present in small amounts in the potato's flesh and skin.

However, those small amounts can increase with improper handling and storage. When potatoes are exposed to light, they turn green because of increased levels of chlorophyll—which can also indicate higher levels of solanine and chaconine. According to researchers at the University of California—Davis, cooking does not destroy these compounds, so it's best to cut away any green areas before cooking. When buying potatoes, it's good to keep in mind that potatoes marketed in a well-lighted retail display can show dramatic increases of glycoalkaloids after just 24 hours: Solanine doubles at a temperature of 45°F, quadruples at 60°F, and is nine times greater at 75°F. So your best bet is to buy potatoes that are marketed in opaque plastic film or paper bags and have been kept in cool environments.
