

James Henry Toy died on July 14, 2024, at his home in Delta Township surrounded by family. He was born in Lansing, Michigan on August 24, 1949, to the late Robert and Mary (Blanks) Toy. He spent his early years living on Jefferson Street (now Oakland Ave.) in Lansing and attending neighborhood schools. Jim graduated from J.W. Sexton High in 1967.

Jim began working for the State of Michigan in 1967 and attended Lansing Community College; he worked on early data systems with punch cards and magnetic tapes for the Treasury Department and then spent a career as a systems analyst for the Department of Management and Budget.

He married his high school sweetheart, Linda Stephens, in 1970. Jim and Linda raised their family in the home they purchased in 1975 where he loved to garden and spend time in the yard. He grew vegetables, flowers, fruit trees and helped his children raise rabbits, ducks, and a few ornery chickens. Jim was proud to put all three of his children through college. He fostered a culture of lifelong learning and curiosity. He enjoyed visiting his children around the country, and the world, as they each began their teaching careers and started their own families. Jim was able to spend time with all five of his grandchildren and took delight in participating in their lives.

When Jim retired at age fifty-three, he began driving charter buses for Dean Trailways. This job quickly became a joy of his retirement; it fulfilled his friendly, outgoing, and adventurous spirit. One of the highlights of this time was driving for the 2010 Olympics in Vancouver, Canada.

In his later retirement, Jim spent time in the community of Westwind in Dunedin, Florida and enjoyed the company of residents and snowbirds. He made time for card games, woodcarving, hosting community "grills," and serving the community. Jim and Linda continued to travel, including a trip to Cornwall England where he met family and visited his grandfather's birthplace.

Jim is survived by his wife of 54 years Linda Marlyn (Stephens) Toy; his three children Stephen and Emily (Conley) Toy of Royal Oak, Michigan; Christine (Toy) and Phillip Spilker

of Cairo, Egypt; Dana (Toy) and Brian Dieterle of Athens, Ohio; grandchildren Esther and Marlyn Toy, Keeva and Dillon Spilker, and Henry Dieterle; his siblings, Charles and Mary Ellen Toy, Martha Toy, and David Toy; his brothers- and sisters-in-law Gary and Barb, Dan and Kim, Jane and Dennis, John and Stephanie, and many cousins, nieces, nephews, and their children. He will be greatly missed by all.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Friday, July 19, 2024, at the Estes-Leadley Greater Lansing Chapel, 325 W. Washtenaw Street, Lansing, Michigan, with interment to follow in Hillside Cemetery. His family will receive friends at the funeral home from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. Thursday, and one hour prior to the funeral service on Friday. 

ruthless politician before whom even his formidable sisters seem to tremble?

As Lucrezia sits in constricting finery for a painting intended to preserve her image for centuries to come, one thing becomes worryingly clear. In the court's eyes, she has one duty: to provide the heir who will shore up the future of the Ferranese dynasty. Until then, for all of her rank and nobility, the new duchess' future hangs entirely in the balance.
