





Resident will then get a reply asking them to respond with their name and lot number, and once done, the registration is complete.

## **Parking Rules**



his is a reminder RE: the parking rules as well as a few changes to occur effective Jan 1st.

\*\*Each home is allowed TWO cars per home, any extras must be removed from the property right away.\*\*

You will be towed for the following:

- 1. Parking in any space around the clubhouse, office or mailboxes between the hours of 8 am and 10 pm, unless you are using the amenities. (900-530 for the office)
- 2. Parking in any space around the clubhouse, office or mailboxes between the hours of 10 pm and 8 am without a RED hang tag or a YELLOW dated guest pass. (530-900 for the office) You can register for either at the office.
- 3. Parking on the street anytime between 1 am and 6 am.
- 4. Parking anywhere on the property without a general parking sticker.
- 5. Parking a commercial vehicle, anywhere on property. This would be any vehicle with any advertising on it. Or any vehicle that is used for commercial rather than personal use.

## Joining the HOA



Association aside from voting rights. HOA Board Meetings BOARD MEETING are official meetings of the Board of Directors and meeting are open to all HOA members and all residents are encouraged to attend but only HOA members can speak and only to agenda items. Please do not feed or put out feeders accessible to ducks or other wildlife. It is illegal in the State of Florida to feed wildlife and you could be charged a \$100 fine for the first infraction.

## **PET Rules and Regulations**

Il pets must be approved by MANAGEMENT in writing before the pet's owner moves into the COMMUNITY, or before RESIDENT obtains a pet after move-in.



No more than two (2) pets per household.

All pets must be on a leash no longer than six (6) feet at any time the pet is outside of RESIDENT'S homesite.

Pets may not be tied unattended outside of RESIDENT'S manufactured home at any time.

Pets may not be walked on the lawns of any homesite in the COMMUNITY, other than RESIDENT'S homesite.

No pet enclosures, including, but not limited to dog houses, are allowed. Pets must be kept inside RESIDENT'S manufactured home if unattended.

Excessive noise is not allowed, and pets must not annoy RESIDENT'S neighbors. Pets must not be left alone if they bark, cry or whine when by themselves.

No pets are allowed in the COMMUNITY recreation areas at any time.

Guests' pets are not permitted in the COMMUNITY.

#### **Don't Leave Them Behind**

urricane season officially "ends" November 1, but natural disasters can strike at anytime. Here are some tips for protecting your furry loved ones in an emergency: In the event that our area is evacuated, never leave companion animals behind to fend for themselves. They aren't any better equipped to survive disasters than humans are. Know your destination ahead of time.

Shelters for human victims don't often allow animals, but Pinellas County has a program you can sign up for. And hotels in our area may allow pets in an emergency. Call destinations in advance and find out which ones will accommodate you and your animals.

Never leave animals unsupervised in a car—they can panic and try to escape or suffer from heatstroke once ambient temperatures rise above 70 degrees, even if water is provided and the windows are slightly open.

Place small animals in secure carriers. Dogs should be leashed because frightening sounds and unfamiliar surroundings may make them bolt. Take water and food bowls, your animal's favorite toy or blanket, a towel, and enough food for at least one week.

Make sure that dogs and cats are microchipped and put legible ID tags with your phone number on them so that your companions can be found in case they get separated from you.

#### **Reminder on Trash Policies**

The dump will be open 8-3 on Tues and Friday, and 8-11 on Saturday. We are going to try this to see if we can keep the illegal dumping under control but still giving you all access. A reminder/the rule, if it wont fit in a large size trash can, it does not belong in the dump area. No furniture, chemicals of any kind, propane tanks, paint, electronics, construction debris, grills, etc...ever. The compactor is for your regular bagged up household trash, the big dumpster is for yard waste and the blue container is for recyclables. ANYTHING ELSE IS THE RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO HAVE HAULED OFF THE PROPERTY because Valet Living won't pick it up either. If you are caught dumping anything else, that is actually a crime, you will be fined by the county, get a violation letter from us, and we will close the area back up. (we don't want that)

Beginning 8/22, the maintenance staff will no longer be going around to pick up trash or yard waste. Valet Living will still pick up your trash, but all of the same policies above apply pertaining to what is allowed in the dump area and what they will and won't pick up. Everything bagged in trash bags and boxes broken down should be it. It doesn't make sense to have them go back and do the same thing we already pay a vendor for and use up man hours when there are so many other things that need attention on the property. This does include yard waste, you will have to take that to the dumpster because Valet Living does not pick that up. I have faith that this will be a smooth transition, if you have any questions, please call us at (727) 531-9105. Thank you.

Boxes MUST be broken down and put into the Recycling container. • No bags whatsoever should be placed in the roll off container. This container is for unbagged yard waste, and other household trash. If you have bagged yard waste, you can put it into the compactor or open the bag and dump the contents into the roll off. • The roll off container is not for bulky furniture or construction material...if it doesn't fit into an outside type of garbage can, it does not belong in the dump area. Just as the park is not responsible for you getting to work on time, paying your cell phone bill, or getting your oil changed, we must follow Pinellas County Solid Waste Ordinances and are not responsible for taking your old mattresses, tires, appliances, TVs, large bulky furniture, paint, batteries, solvents, construction debris, etc. Again, the roll off and compactor is for "household" trash only. Therefore, you will need to arrange to have prohibited items hauled away or you can take it to the landfill which we believe costs approximately \$11 for a load. The Pinellas County Solid Waste landfill is located at 3095 114th Ave. N., St. Petersburg, FL 33716, about 10 miles away. Their phone number is 727-464-7500. There are several junk removal companies, and we know of one junk hauler, Tampa Bay Junk Pros, who may be offering \$50 off for junk/furniture/ appliance removal. Their number is 727-404-5100. • Do not fill the roll off container past the fill line, otherwise it will not be emptied resulting in having to lockdown the dumpster area which is inconvenient for all. If it is full, you may place your items to the side of the container so maintenance can put it in for you once the container

is emptied.

#### What to do:

Move individual out of the sun, lay them down and loosen clothing
 Apply cool, damp cloths
 Fan or move individual to air conditioned room
 Give sips of water (discontinue if nausea occurs)
 If vomiting continues, seek medical attention
 Call 911 or get to hospital (delay can be fatal)
 Move individual to cooler or air conditioned room
 Lower body temperature with water mister and fan
 Do not give fluids



We realize that putting your trash out attracts all sorts of pesky critters and birds. Crows in particular are very opportunistic. They typically go for the easiest target. We are suggesting that you purchase black bags over white bags because birds cannot see what is in them. We are not saying it is an absolute solution, but it does tend to help. If you choose to continue to use white bags, you may want to consider wrapping food waste in

plastic Walmart/Publix grocery bags before putting it in the garbage bag. In reviewing some forums on similar trash issues, some folks have had success in spraying their bags with ammonia water. Others state that they use weighted nets to cover their trash bags. Curious if a pop up net laundry hamper with a lid (as shown below) to put the bags curbside may be worth a try. If you are considering trying that as a solution, just make sure that you put a note for Valet Service that the hamper is to remain. And you may want to weight the bottom of the hamper so it doesn't fly away. If anyone has found a solution that works, please let us know so that we can pass it on.
