



PRESIDENT'S CORNER

o say the last 30 days have been a challenge is an understatement. "Phew," is all I can say. We hope October will signal the end of the mayhem. It is an understatement to say our staff has been pushed to their max. It is a lot to manage, in any given day, to maintain focus on the highest business priorities as we work on resident concerns, market studies, insurance comparisons, legal cases, annual budget, asset valuations, proxy voting, real estate transactions, committee work, new home installations, constant repair/replacement work quoting and meeting management to name only a few. "No, that is not enough," said the universe. "Let's see what else we can throw at them?" The last three to four weeks went something like this...

Water, water, water everywhere! After the heavy rains, and because rain continued for many days following Tropical Storm Debby, we have experienced some unique situations. Some of our roads experienced "splaying" a breakdown of asphalt. The Roadway Committee, led by Gary Thrasher, met with the vendor, ACPLM, who committed to repair at no charge because the cause was not only the flexing of the roads due to the high water-table but also the result of thinly laid pavement that did not meet contract minimums. An approach will be proposed to ferret out any additional areas of concern. It was discovered one of our catch basins requires repair. The collar has worn away disallowing the grate to settle in properly. The good news is the roads and catch basins handled directing the heavy flow of storm water into the drainage system as expected.

After replacing a lift station pump in June/July, our sewer system backed up in direct correlation to the city sewer system being overwhelmed by storm water. Our staff literally "jumped in" (if you know what I mean) and did a great job addressing the park's concern. I am sad to report shoes were ruined in the process! The back-up did not harm any home interiors but could have if it had not been addressed as quickly as it was by the city (at no charge). Thank you to Marilyn Corazza and Ron Endicott for being on top of it! You've been awarded the coveted "Johnny on the Spot" award.

Florida heat and humidity are hanging in like you read about. To say it has been difficult to work outdoors is an understatement. Our cement wall remains unpainted due to the weather. Our vendor working to refurbish the shuffle court surface has had difficulty completing his work due to high humidity, preventing drying. Our roof replacement work was frequently delayed but is finally complete. Our pool-goers are happily back bobbing in the water. One of the older geothermal pool heaters failed and is being addressed. We repaired the wiring on one end of our pool gate access system this year and now the other pool gate is having electrical issues. The pavers surrounding the hot tub and outdoor shower area, as well as along the pool edge coping,











are caving and require replacement. Project quotes are being obtained to resolve these issues. A corner on the housing that surrounds our glassed-in poster/notice board next to the shuffle court has been damaged and the soffit and trim are rotting from constant moisture, requiring repair.

American Roofing did a fabulous job on our roof replacement project. Unfortunately our preexisting air conditioners were reinstalled by our A/C vendor 'as is' with an unfinished look. This situation presented an unsightly view from our pool area. To resolve, additional flashing was applied around the exposed pressure treated curbing, but painting of the units (where the original side-vent air ducts once were) will have to wait for better weather.

There's more! Ground swell... our lawn care vendor could not complete their work last week because the ground was so soggy. They returned once conditions improved. The high-water table resulted in seepage under the cement wall outside the Oleander gate. Once again, Marilyn called the city in. The situation was corrected by bringing in equipment and digging out the ditches along the outside of the wall designed to move the water to the canal.

So much more has been addressed that is considered standard daily practice. Yes, rules violation letters have been sent and more are coming. Fining Committee meetings may be right around the corner if behaviors are not corrected VERY SOON. Every resident has the right to peaceful enjoyment of their home. We expect this to extend to the use of our common areas, as well as the work environment created for our staff. When addressing staff members or one another, please consider your tone of voice. How we connect and support one another is paramount to building a great community. It is NOT difficult to follow the rules. Doing so shows respect for oneself and others. It is a simple concept to treat others the way you would like to be treated. Please choose to be a good citizen. Honor your agreement to follow the association rules. Let's make this a great park! WE CAN DO IT!

HOMESITE MAINTENANCE

don't like being redundant, but I need to bring up "Homesite Maintenance" again. What exactly is Homesite Maintenance? It is keeping the outer portions of your home clean and orderly and complying with Article VII. HOMESITES of the Sunset Palms Rules & Regulations.

These rules apply to your home, carport, driveway, patio, storage, and the exterior around your home.

I am not going to list the individual rules again but want to ask a few questions:

Did you forget that you are storing a ladder behind your unit? *I am sure your neighbor that sits on their back patio has not.*

Are you really going to use those 2 x 4's or paver stones that you have been storing along the side of your home?

If you have not used them, you aren't going to. Please get rid of them.

Have you purchased a new recliner and moved your old one out to your carport? *If it did not work in your living room anymore, it does not work in your carport either.*

Do you have dead plants in flowerpots that you have been meaning to replace or empty or broken flowerpots that are in your carport, on your patio, alongside your home or in your yard? Replace the plants or get rid of the flowerpots – no one wants to look at dead plants or empty flowerpots.

Are there boxes stacked in your carport?

It is time to open the boxes and sort through them or take them to a storage facility.

It is easy to forget that what does not bother you (out of sight out of mind) may be bothering your neighbors. So, take a walk around your property and make sure that you are not storing things that you have forgotten about!

It is important that you comply with the Sunset Palms Rules & Regulations. These rules are in place for your safety and to maintain harmony in our community.



HURRICANE SEASON is June 1st – November 30th. Please remove any loose items around the exterior of your home that can be blown away or knocked down during a storm. The storms have been coming up quickly this year and it is better to be prepared than try to prepare when the storm is on its way.



Grandparent and Family Scams

Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to keep it a secret.

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: sometimes using information from social networking sites, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

- Stop. Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and call another family member to check out the story.
- Pass this information on to a friend. You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.
