





President's Report

Some in the community question why the board can proceed with large projects such as the seawall, boat ramp, or even smaller reserve projects such as exercise room without a community vote.

The primary difference is whether the project is NEW vs EXISTING. The \$9,999 spending provision pertains to new capital improvements vs existing. The board can approve new capital improvements with costs up to this amount. Costs above this amount require a membership vote. Examples would be the installation of the kayak docks, shade at the bocce court, smoking pad at the pool area, TV monitors outside the clubhouse.

Reserves on the other hand are for the express purpose of replacing or maintaining existing infrastructure or amenities and do not require a membership vote. Reserves are typically collected over several years and they are based on expected replacement costs and timing. Examples would be our roads, seawall, roofs, AC Units, pool, and buildings. These all have a life expectancy and replacement of these items needs to be planned and accrued for over time.

The reserve funding is based on a reserve study which is developed with the assistance of an independent engineering firm that specializes in these studies.

The reserve fund operates as a pooled account. This means it is a single bucket of money used for various needs. The allocation of funds is based on estimated needs, costs, and timing of replacements. Funds can be used for purposes (previously unforeseen), other than initially planned, however, they must be replenished to ensure future needs are met. This approach helps prevent the disrepair seen in some communities that don't properly fund reserves and avoids the need for special assessments.

As we begin our 2025/2026 budget process it is important to understand there are two primary components to the budget, one is the reserve study contribution and the other is the annual operating fund. While your board has worked hard to identify and implement cost savings, and generate new forms of revenue, recent inflation rates will undoubtedly impact the budgeting process. Water and sewerage rates, trash pickup, electricity, etc. have all gone up significantly and will need to be accounted for during the budget process.

We encourage you to attend the budget planning sessions to better understand the process and how our annual budget is generated.



Who Can Be Hypnotized?

o be hypnotized, a person must have an IQ of at least 80, have the ability to focus and concentrate (the stronger the better), and be collaborative. That covers most of us!

Some fear they will lose control, tell secrets, act silly, or do something inappropriate under hypnosis; a competent hypnotist can explain how and why these fears are unfounded. That said, all questions about the process are welcome by all professional hypnotherapists, so any person with questions or uncertainties should feel free to ask. In addition, clients are encouraged to share with the therapist any good and bad feeling they have, so that the therapist can modify the process to fit the clients' needs better.

The consensus is that almost everyone can be hypnotized, and that their experience under hypnosis can vary greatly. For some, relaxation is necessary and enjoyable, for others, focus comes with concentration. At times, false beliefs and fear can impair a person's ability to enter a hypnotic state, so I'll mention again that a good, open conversation with the therapist is important.

The most important element for a positive, effective hypnotic session may well be the willingness of the client to collaborate with the hypnotist.



There will be a BBQ of Hamburgers & Hot Dogs & Drinks.



"I've had buyers look at two homes and one will have drywall while the other has painted paneling. Every time, buyers will say, 'I like this home, but I don't know why.' Then when I point out the drywall, they will agree that made the difference," explains Pozgay.
- Additional storage: Storage is always at a premium and most buyers are downsizing from
 a larger home. When a home has an organized and large shed with shelving that will add
 value in the minds of buyers. Pozgay notes, "If two homes are competing for a buyer,
 often it comes down to storage."





Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to keep it a secret.

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: sometimes using information from social networking sites, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

- Stop. Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and call another family member to check out the story.
- Pass this information on to a friend. You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.


