New pool lounge chairs are scheduled for delivery and the country cottage tables have been shipped. If the pool opens prior to arrival of furniture- we will accommodate with the old tables and chairs until arrival. Our pool bottom was required to be white by the state. Reminder: four (4) reminders- 1. Shower before entering pool. 2. No suntan lotion or oil is allowed to be put on while in the pool. If you are heavily oiled or using bronzers- please rinse off before entering the pool. 3. No drinks are allowed in the pool area as well as no glass containers - drinks are to be back at chairs or tables. 4. Flotation devices- if the pool is crowded- rafts take up two much room.

Electric/water heater update. The electric lines have all been run through the clubhouse. Duke Energy is in the process of installing a new transformer for the electric. As soon as it is completed, the heaters will be operational.

Please do not try to adjust any equipment on the pool filtration system. Maintenance, Manager and pool company are the ones to monitor and make adjustments.

Clubhouse - please do not adjust the temperature down to 70. Have found it running all night at 70. Having it that low and with the intense heat this summer has given us makes condensation- then leakage. We are on a quarterly schedule to clean /drain the ac drains handled by maintenance.

REMINDER- Bicycles- electric or not, scooters, golf carts and motor vehicles must maintain staying under 15 Mph and must all be required to stop at stop signs.
