

Do not touch a power line or anything in contact with it, and keep others away until help arrives.

Sign up for phone, email or text alerts with outage alerts, Duke Energy will notify you by text, voice message or email when there is an outage in your area. They will send estimated restoration times, any information they have about the cause of the outage and status of the crews working to restore power. Sign up now to get phone or email alerts or you can text REG to 57801* to get text alerts. *Message and data rates may apply. Text STOP to cancel

You fill out the information and place one pamphlet in your glove compartment and one on your refrigerator. If anyone is in a crash or has a medical emergency and are nonverbal or confused, all this information is readily available for the responders. Continue to call and get the Security Assessment and Lock Boxes. Once installed, you can give the code to whomever you choose. LPD has it on file for emergencies. 

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- · Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the image, name, or details have been used elsewhere.
- Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- · Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual **promises to meet in person** but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- · Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov

Hearing Aids for Military retirees: The Defense Department's Retiree-At-Cost Hearing Aid Program (RACHAP) helps retirees buy hearing aids through certain military medical facilities at a government-negotiated cost. The hearing aids provided are the same as those available to active-duty service members. The program is open to retirees who have hearing loss or tinnitus (ringing in the ears). Dependents of military retirees are not eligible.

Retirees can use any military treatment facility that provides the program and will accept them; you don't need to return to your service affiliation to participate in this program. Retirees can obtain hearing aids at significant savings: Two hearing aids usually cost less than \$2,000. Exact costs are variable and subject to change at any time without notice. Contact your nearest audiology clinic for further details. Not every military medical facility is able to provide this program. Care of active-duty members takes precedence at all military treatment facilities. It is recommended that you contact the appropriate military facility before incurring significant travel expenses. Facilities may discontinue this program for any reason.




