





#### **Letters to the Editor**

#### THANKS TO ELAINE BLANK FOR THIS:

ur beloved Westwind Community suffered unbelievable damage from Helene. Status as of today, October 2, 2024, Fifth Street was totally inundated by water washing into the homes, electric meters, cars and anything that was in the path. It continued up to 6th Street and 7th Street. There is still no electricity in most of Westwind I and a few homes in Westwind II. On my walk this morning, the debris was piled high on the sidewalk: carpet, cabinets, furniture, appliances, flooring, furniture, and all sorts of household items. Windows were open in the units that are occupied. Car doors are standing open and the smell of mold is in the air. The duct work has been dragged out from under and the cement blocks are being removed to allow air to get under the units. In my discussion with a Duke Energy worker, I was told that all the electric meters that were under water are gone and they don't know the condition of the pedestals and wires in the ground. Until they can access the condition of the wires, they cannot turn on the power. It is important that if your power is out that you turn off your main breaker because when the power comes back on if you have water in your wiring it is very likely your home will catch fire. Please follow the advice of your manager, the utility workers and city and county officials. Our community has worked together to try and locate some folks temporarily in some of the snow birds' homes in Westwind II. Unfortunately, at this writing, we have one death, *Stan Hopkins from unit #514*. Our hearts are heavy today but we are grateful for the spirit and determination of the community to come together and help where we can.
