PRESIDENT'S CORNER

ince our last newsletter publication, a Special Meeting of the Membership was held on September 24th to calculate votes in support of changes to our common area elements for two projects: Shuffle court and Wal-Mart Gate. As I expect you are all aware, we did not have a high enough response rate to achieve the 66 and 2/3% approval required to support these projects. I'd like to thank all who worked in support of this initiative. The VIP Committee will hold a meeting in November to discuss the next steps.

Following the impact of Tropical Storm Debby and Hurricane Helene, we experienced the unimaginable impact of Hurricane Milton. There has been so much destruction statewide! The collective 2024 hurricane season impact to our park thus far resulted in over 20% (100 homes) experiencing some manner of damage. In addition, we have damage to every common area structure in the park, the details of which are still being determined as of this writing.

I'd like to thank our staff for their selfless dedication. My heart is filled with pride from the degree to which our board and residents are stepping up to assist with every aspect of damage assessment and recovery. People were checking in with one another to ensure safety. The moment daylight dawned, concerned residents were out taking a stalk of the overall condition of the park. They helped share time sensitive and critical information to other owners settling nerves from afar. Our staff worked resolution to broken water lines, loss of power to the park, an inoperable lift station, flooded pool pumps, securing hazardous chemicals resulting from the total loss of a storage shed near the pool and the list goes on, all while managing time sensitive updates.

Then, what I call "the muscle" arrived. I heard Dominic Calandra on the other end of the phone, "We're returning to help the park, Jan," he said, and I choked back the tears at the offer. Clearing the streets and responding to unit owner requests for assistance was all beyond what we could offer through our employees at that time. God bless the Calvary!! It freed up our team to get on the phone and work park recovery efforts of common elements that everyone was dependent upon. While I am sure it felt like none of it could happen fast enough, the truth is, it was a miracle to find any availability from our vendors within 48 hours of the disastrous event.

As difficult as it is to frame it this way, we were blessed in so many ways. Sometimes it takes an event like this to remind us we are ONE and we are SUNSET PALMS STRONG! We are still in the thralls of this as I write this article but, rest assured, after-action initiatives will take place. The board of directors will work on your behalf to implement a back-up recovery system to ensure history does not repeat itself in quite the same way as was experienced this week. Our




