






The first eureka moment

rchimedes, the Greek mathematician (born in Syracuse in 287 B.C.) was a genius in the application of geometry to mechanical devices. Indeed, according to Thereby Hangs a Tale, by Charles E. Funk, he was the Thomas Edison of his day.

In fact, Funk says, that more than 2,000 years after his death we are still making great use out of his discoveries and inventions, and have merely been able to improve upon them.

Once, Archimedes had before him the task of deter-mining the amount of silver a dishonest goldsmith had used in the making of a crown, which had been ordered in pure gold, for the king.

Archimedes worried over the problem to no avail until one day when he stepped into his bath. The bath had been filled to the brim and when he stepped into it, it overflowed. Archimedes noticed that the bath was full and that a certain amount of water had overflowed. This gave him his first inkling of the law of hydrostatics, which says that a body surrounded by a fluid is buoyed up by a force equal to the weight of the fluid it displaces.

Now Archimedes knew that by weighing out an equal amount of gold to the weight of the crown, and then by putting them separately into basins of water, that the difference in the amount of overflow would give him the answer to the problem of the crown, because the weight of the overflow would denote the amount of alloy.

Poor Archimedes was so excited by his discovery and the chance to test it that he jumped out of the bath, and without his clothes he ran home, astonishing passersby, while shouting "Eureka, eureka!" which means "I have found it, I have found it!"

Americans and their snacking habit



Americans love snacks, and define the ideal snack as "healthy, tastes sinful, and is convenient in all aspects" (The International Dairy, Deli & Bakery Association). Here are some other facts gleaned from the article, "The New Snack is Healthy," by Michelle Moran.

- An estimated 90 percent of Americans indulge in a snack on any given day.
- 74 percent of Americans snack in the evening.
- 75 percent of Americans eat breakfast.
- 88 percent of Americans eat lunch.
- It is estimated that sales of snack foods will rise from the 2003 \$47.1 billion to \$57.3 billion in 2008.
- 33.5 percent of Americans decreased their snacking in the past two years; 30.8 percent increased their snacking.
- Twenty-five percent of adults prefer foods that are easy to prepare; 10 percent don't have time to prepare healthy snacks or meals; 5 percent often eat store-made, precooked meals.

Want to reduce pain - try meditation

In a recent study, 12 healthy, long-term meditators, who had been practicing meditation for 30 years, showed 40 percent to 50 percent lower brain response to pain when compared to 12 healthy adults who did not meditate. The study was published in a recent article in the journal NeuroReport. Also of note, the study found that when the 12 controls in the study learned and practiced meditation for five months, their responses to pain also decreased by the same 40 percent to 50 percent.



Researchers believe that meditation can reduce pain by producing a physical state that modifies the pain level. That is why meditation has been found to reduce anxiety, improve reactions to stress and decrease acute pain.

It is estimated that 50 million people in the world suffer from chronic pain, and it appears that meditation can reduce that pain by half in many people.

David Orme-Johnson, lead author of the study, says "Prior research indicates that transcendental meditation creates a more balanced outlook on life and a greater equanimity in reacting to stress. This study suggests that this is not just an attitudinal change, but a fundamental change in how the brain functions."





How snakes can see in the dark





According to snake expert Michael Grace, in an ABCNews article titled "How Snakes see two ways?" snakes can use their eyes to see, just like humans do. But they can also use infrared sensors to conjure images based on heat emitted by objects in the environment. Grace says snakes have the ability to switch back and forth in using these two ways of seeing and can also use them simultaneously.

Andreas B. Sichert, Paul Friedel and Leo van Hemmen, in an article in the *Physical Review*, say that snakes have small cavities near their snouts—and these cavities are known as pit organs. Snakes can localize heat sources by using their pit organs, which are sensitive to infrared radiation emitted by prey, such as rats and rabbits—and Samuel L. Jackson, the scientists say. However, they also say that because the pit organs are not very deep and the pit apertures are wide, that the snakes could not use them to track prey very well. But when it comes to the close confines of a plane, the snakes could use this ability to track prey in the dark.







- 2. Check on your turkey: If you're cooking a turkey, stay home and check on it frequently ¹.
- 3. Keep children away from the stove: Ensure kids stay at least three feet away from the stove and hot surfaces ¹.
- 4. Avoid loose clothing: Wear short or tight-fitting sleeves to prevent clothes from catching fire ².
- 5. Use timers: Set timers to remind yourself that the stove or oven is on ².
- 6. Keep flammable items away: Move items like dishtowels, bags, and paper away from the stove ³.
- 7. Have a fire extinguisher handy: Keep a fire extinguisher in the kitchen and know how to use it ².
- 8. Test smoke alarms: Make sure your smoke alarms are working by testing them before you start cooking 1.
- 9. Practice food safety: Thaw your turkey in the fridge, avoid cross-contamination, and refrigerate leftovers promptly ².
- 10. Be cautious with turkey fryers: If using a turkey fryer, follow all safety instructions, or consider buying a pre-cooked fried turkey ¹. Have a wonderful and safe Thanksgiving!


