

keep taking care when outside. Here's a mostly new topic. First, when you set your trash out, make sure that it is secure. Please remember that birds and wildlife will consider your trash to be a treasure and then it ends up everywhere and can be very dangerous and unhealthy for the humans and pets in the Park.

Second, there is NO feeding of wildlife in Teakwood Village. This includes birds, cats, dogs as well as squirrels, rabbits and opossums, and any of the like. The wildlife will become used to humans as their food source and will no longer be able to survive. This can result in the wild animals being aggressive to people demanding food. You could also be harming the animals as you are feeding them food that may have no health benefits, and can actually harm the animals. Both of these items can, and have harmed residents' pets. If you don't secure your trash, wildlife gets into it, takes some into another person's yard, abandons it, the pet comes out on the leash and dogs being quick, can grab this trash and rotten food, eat it and then become very ill. This is not bad pet ownership. Dogs are just quicker than humans when they are going after something they want but shouldn't have.

Follow up on that. You may be trying to be kind, but do not put treats outside a home for that home's pets and don't offer treats unless you have the express permission of the pet owner. The pet may have a restricted diet due to health and medical needs that you are not aware of. Recap: Secure your trash, don't feed wildlife and don't feed your neighbor's pets without the owner's permission (every time you go to feed the pet something).



#### **PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT**

here has been some concern about the removal of snapped trees and palms that were damaged due to hurricane Milton. Many broken palms have already been cut down and removed. If you have a tree or palm on your property that has NOT fallen but you feel may be a hazard, you will need to first get a tree removal permit if the palm is more than 4 ½ ft tall or tree is more than 4 inches in diameter. You can get a permit on-line or at City Hall. The permit fee is being waived for 60 days (contact City Hall for the deadline date). Second you would have to hire and pay for the tree to be removed.




#### TROUBADOURS CONCERT







URKEY TIME!
Have leftover turkey from your Thanksgiving meal? You can use some of it in this recipe.
If you don't have turkey, chicken can be substituted.

#### **TURKEY TETRAZZINI**

- 1 Tbsp. butter
- 1/2 c finely chopped onion
- 1/3 c finely chopped celery
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 c. frozen peas
- 1/4 c. carrot
- 1/2 c white wine

- 1/2 c flour
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1 c parmesan cheese (divided)
- 4 oz. cream cheese
- 1 (8 oz) pkg. thin spaghetti cooked
- 2 cups turkey meat, cooked and shredded
- 1/2 c. breadcrumbs

Preheat oven to 350. Melt butter in saute pan. Add onion, celery pepper, salt, carrots. Saute until vegetables are tender. Add flour and stir until vegetables are coated. Add wine and stir quickly until flour is absorbed. Gradually add broth, stirring constantly. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer 5 minutes, stirring frequently. Remove from heat. Add 1/2 c. Parmesan cheese and the cream cheese, stirring until cheese melts. Add the peas, turkey and pasta. Stir until blended.

Coat a casserole with non-stick spray and transfer mixture to the casserole. Combine breadcrumbs with 1/2 c Parmesan cheese. Sprinkle mixture evenly over top of casserole. Bake at 350 for 30 min until lightly browned. Let rest for 15 min. before serving.

#### **APPLE CRISP**

- 4 c. peeled and sliced apples
- 1/2 c. butter
- 1/2 c. flour


- 1 tsp. cinnamon


