





To All Residents - Royal Palm Cemetery

Royal Palm Cemetery is now off limits to all residents with dogs. The cemetery will be putting up "no trespassing" signs for anyone with a dog. There have been many complaints that people are taking their dogs to the cemetery for walks and not cleaning up after them. Anyone caught on cemetery property will be prosecuted.

A reminder that pets are not allowed to go onto other people's lots unless they have permission to do so. This is in the park rules.

Your Options:

You can let your pet go in your own yard before walking it.

You can walk your pet to the pet-walking areas.

You can let your pet go on the road. Yes, they pull to go into people's yard's but you are in control of your pet, you pet does not control you.

Pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet. Retractable leashes extend many feet, often blocking the whole road. This is also in the park rules.

Some people get upset at pets doing their business in their yards. Not everyone loves your pet, so please obey the rules, and be sure to pick up after your pet.

Home Site Alterations

If you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home, please come to the office and submit a completed request (green sheet). Paint colors must be approved, and a request form must be approved. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval before proceeding with any work. Anyone other than the homeowner working on the home must be licensed and insured and we must have a copy of such on file in the office.

Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- · Bills for items you did not buy
- · Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- · Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The **Federal Trade Commission** (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- · Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in **authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your bank or a company you do business with. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.
