

In my haste to pack, as I had exactly 10 hours to do the last -minute preparations in the house and decide what I can pack in my suite case that will be helpful if I never see my house again, what a dreadful thought! Evacuating in my car was one thing but a suit case? At the last minute I threw in my yellow book Park directory. I had been in constant contact with Joy to see how I could help as she had a call from the Fire Department wanting the names and unit numbers of the people who refused to evacuate. This information was to be used to identify the victims of the storm. As soon as I arrived at my son's house, I got a list from Joy of all the people that she wasn't sure where they were. I picked up my yellow book directory and much to my dismay, there were some numbers that were no longer in service.

Fortunately, the rest of the folks either answered or were not home so I left a message. I can't stress enough how important it is to keep your information updated in the office. The good news is we didn't have to identify any bodies but it was certainly disappointing after all the hours that Sylvia and I put in on getting the directory updated that we had so many people who changed phone numbers and didn't let us know. We have only Westwind II resident information in our office but I have the whole park WW I and WW II names and numbers on a special computer in the conference room at the office and I update that all the time and try to put any changes, additions and deletions in the "Hi- Lites." I am asking any Westwind

resident to call me or text me at 440-552-6566 or email me at eandtblank@msn. com to correct any information that is in the 2024/2025 directory. Please check your listing and let me know if you need any changes.



OUTDOOR CHANDELIERS have become VERY popular in Dunedin, FL.—If you drive through the residential streets surrounding downtown, you will see MANY hanging chandeliers.—I decided to make one for our home in Ohio.—Pagarbaged-picked" the chandelier from an upscale neighbor where I often ride my bike.—That chandelier was like brand new.—If sells for\$150.00 in Home Depot.].—I ordered a brown string of clear Christmas lights off-play.—I attached them with thin gauged black zip ties.—I removed the 4.X-110V-receptacles from the lights which look like candles.—I put in low voltage lights in their place.—I was able to hide the low voltage cords in the metal tubing.—This chandelier has 2 separate power cords. 1 for the Xmas lights and 1 for the low voltage lights.—They both exit the chandelier at the top so they are not visible.





Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to keep it a secret.

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: sometimes using information from social networking sites, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

- **Stop**. Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and call another family member to check out the story.
- Pass this information on to a friend. You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.
