ALERT Romance Scams

Romance scams occur when a criminal adopts a fake online identity to gain a victim's affection and trust. The scammer then uses the illusion of a romantic or close relationship to manipulate and/or steal from the victim.

The scammer's intention is to establish a relationship as quickly as possible, endear himself to the victim, and gain trust. Scammers may propose marriage and make plans to meet in person, but that will never happen. Eventually, they will ask for money.

If someone you meet online needs your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other theft and fraud schemes.

Tips for Avoiding Romance Scams:

- Be careful what you post and make public online. Scammers can use details shared on social media and dating sites to better understand and target you.
- Research the person's photo and profile using online searches to see if the **image**, **name**, **or details have been used elsewhere**. Go slowly and ask lots of questions.
- Beware if the individual seems too perfect or quickly asks you to leave a dating service or social media site to communicate directly.
- Beware if the individual attempts to isolate you from friends and family or requests inappropriate photos or financial information that could later be used to extort you.
- Beware if the individual **promises** to meet in person but then always comes up with an excuse why he or she can't. If you haven't met the person after a few months, for whatever reason, you have good reason to be suspicious.
- Never send money to anyone you have only communicated with online or by phone. ReportFraud.ftc.gov

That being said, Brightview Landscaping services has offered a very reasonable fee of \$35 for Palm Tree trimming only. Any other type of tree, or removal of a tree will be on a case-by-case basis between Brightview and the homeowner.

Any homeowner who wants to take advantage of this service needs to contact Chris Roush: Christopher.Roush@Brightview.com and have your name, home number and how many trees on your lot put on his list. To ensure the right tree is trimmed, the homeowner needs to have a blue ribbon placed around the tree(s). Pre-cut blue ribbons are available at the clubhouses hanging on the HOA Bulletin boards. Please just take what you need. I provided the first three rolls, if more ribbons are needed, Ace sells rolls 1-1/2" x 300' for under \$5.

Once Brightview has at least 20 residents, Chris will reach out to you and schedule a date for the service and set-up payment of services. The HOA is not involved in contacting Brightview or handling any monies.

This trimming service is a set procedure of cutting the fronds. Any resident requesting different cutting style will pay an additional fee depending on the custom cut requested.

In a community this large, some folks have trouble being civil when dealing with others. Brightview is giving us a good deal, please don't take it out on them if you disagree with this issue. Any resident that disrespects the contractor, he has the right to remove you from his list. Any problems with the trimming, need to be brought to Chris' attention.





Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- · Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three major credit reporting agencies. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The fraud department at your credit card issuers, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- Do not answer phone calls, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or people you do not know.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- Collect your mail every day and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- Understand how ATM skimming works and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. Do not carry it in your wallet.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone** in authority. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- Government imposter scams Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- IRS imposter scams scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- Social Security imposter scams scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- Charity scams scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- Grandparent scams scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- Tech support scams scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your **bank or a company you do business with.** You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.
